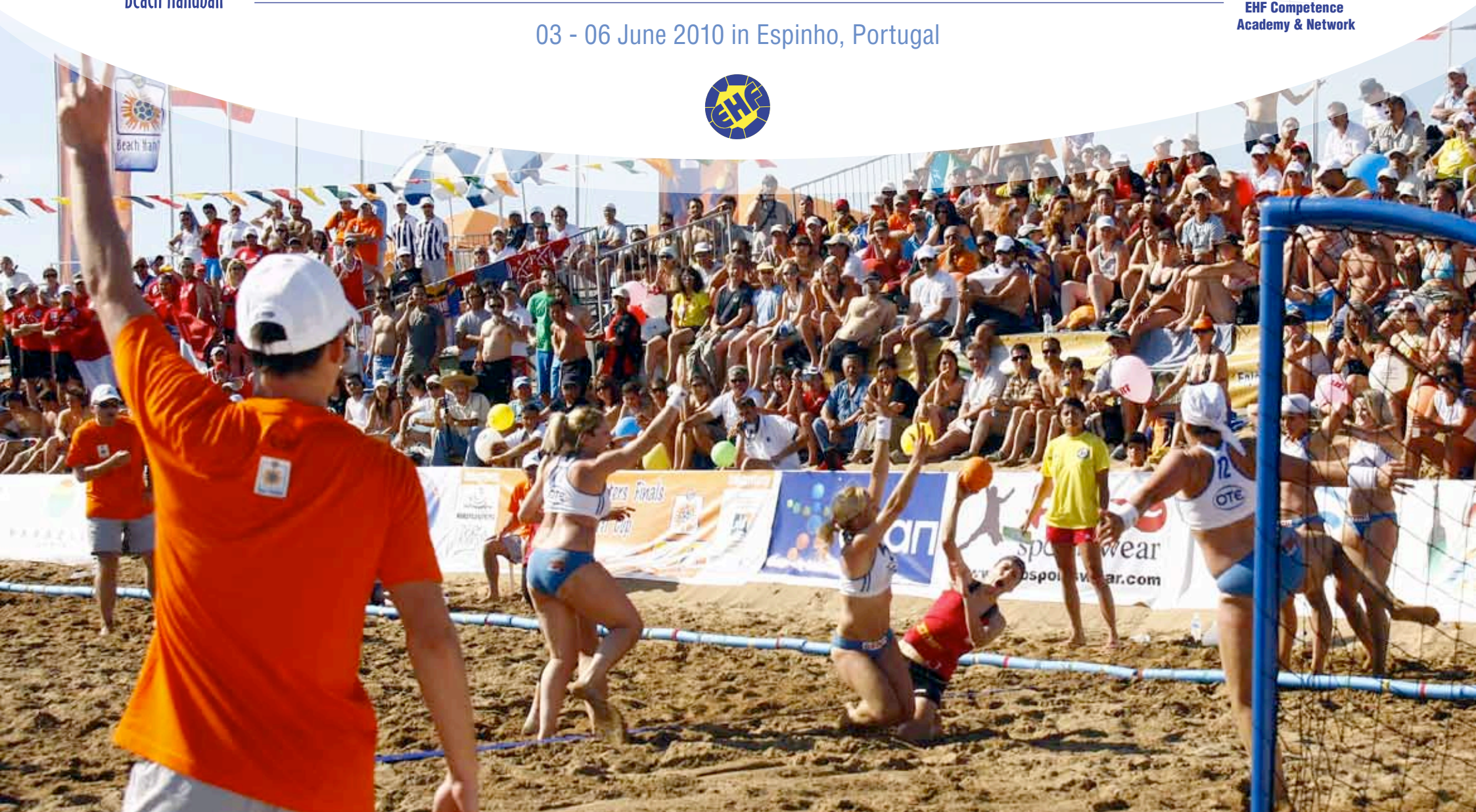

Espinho, Portugal

The city of Espinho was founded by a group of fishermen from Furadouro, near Ovar, who began to seek its sea because sardines were more abundant, and ended by building their homes here in the beginning of the 19th century.

The quantity of fish available at the coastal zone contributed to settle the population but it was only in the 20th century that Espinho began to experience a real development and expansion, thanks to its fine beaches which started to be sought by bathers, namely after the arrival of the railway in 1870, who came to spend their holidays here to profit from “sea cures”.

From this period, several typical “Summer bathing” houses may still be seen, exhibiting happy and colourful façades and long verandas.

The city is now a popular tourism resort and visited by thousands of holiday-makers, namely from Oporto and its environs, attracted not only by the sea and beaches but also because of its casino, one of Portugal’s main gambling sites. Espinho also offers good conditions to play golf.



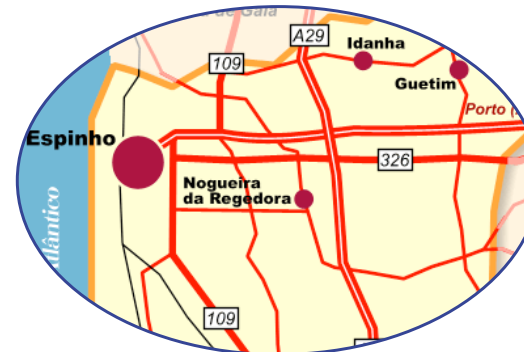
It is worth visiting the pretty Mother Church and strolling along the sea-side promenade with the fishermen’s houses on one side and the beach and esplanades on the other, and at the end the Chapel of Our Lady of Assistance, patron saint of seafarers and fishermen, and the fish market.

Each monday, the city still preserves the traditional Espinho Fair with hundreds of stalls and improvised selling spots offering a little of everything, from handicrafts to agricultural products sold directly by farmers.

South of the city, the small village of Paramos maintains the charm of a typical fishing community.

Nearby, an ancient settlement, probably dating from the 2nd century BC, Castro d’Ovil, was discovered more than two decades ago and is now open to visitors.

In terms of gastronomy, Espinho does justice to its traditional connection to the sea and boasts of many restaurants serving excellent caldeirada (fresh fish stew) and shellfish.



EHF Beach Handball Commission

The EHF Beach Handball Commission (26/27 September 2008) regards itself as an initiator of projects in order to develop Beach Handball as an independent sport discipline within the European Handball family. One of the main targets of the BC is the education of facilitators. Combined educational courses of referees, delegates and coaches have been organised since 1999.

The European Handball Federation (EHF) is the governing body of Handball in Europe! Its 50 Member Federations represent and stand for 50 different kinds of national and international handball know-how. Those individual national handball schools/philosophies shall be made use of by involving experts in order to contribute to the variety of handball education in Europe!

Handball know-how exchange and transfer in Europe shall be fostered as an EHF service for the EHF Member Federations by making use of national and international handball experts as well as external lecturers from sport science, medicine, other sports, economy (marketing, equipment suppliers) and media (press, TV, Internet).

The EHF Competence Academy & Network (EHF CAN) shall be established as an educational service centre for EHF Member Federations with the possibility of granting scholarships in order to minimize or delete financial burdens for them. The same holds good for internal EHF Office management training on the job.

The EHF "CAN" shall be established to develop and deliver sport specific educational and training programmes in order to ensure that coaches, officials, athletes and administrators from all over Europe (and the world) have access to the highest quality education relating to "handball know-how" and competence in e-learning, blended learning, interdisciplinary educational courses of various duration, summer schools or mainstream 2-4 semester courses within the European Education Credit Transfer System (ECTS framework).

The EHF "CAN" shall set-up Business Executive Education programmes for further educating and training sporting administrators, resort managers and event executives in the Handball Event Management Business, e.g. also in event-related courses.

The EHF "CAN" shall contain a documentation centre including production of modern teaching aids and media as well as cooperation agreements with research&developing partners, suppliers, universities and testifying institutions.

(for delegate candidates)** Beach Handball experience / involvement in the national Beach Handball activities
Under 40 years of age
English as a foreign language is obligatory
Female delegates are very welcome
Nominations of federations which have no Beach Handball delegates are preferred

Basic requirement tests: **Referees:** Health confirmation obligatory (not older than 2 months) – physical test on 28.05.09

Course Fee: € 300 (will be borne by the EHF; in cases of late withdrawal the course fee has to be paid – see registration form)

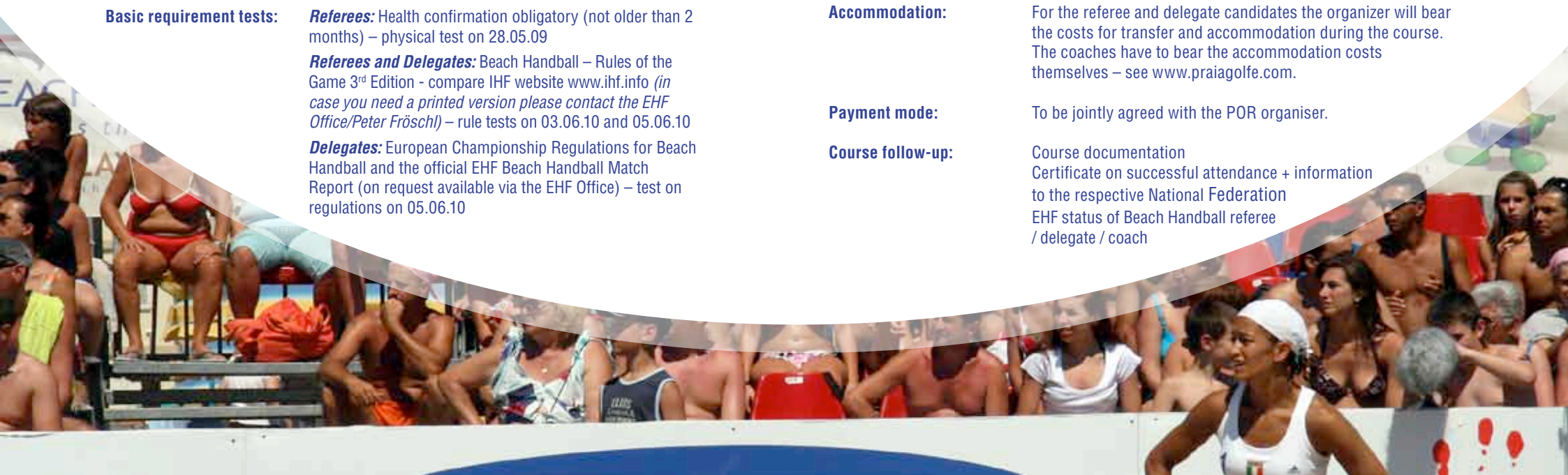
Travel: All participants have to organise the travel and to pay the travel expenses themselves.
