EHF OPENING & CLOSING

Jan Tuik/EHF CC Chairman opens the seminar by referring to the new EHF policy of nominating EHF Euro Event referees, starting with a "kick-off" seminar at the beginning of a 4 month preparatory cycle. EHF CAN will provide facilities to optimize the physical preparation as well as the mental coaching and guidance during the tournament. Expertise from the coaches' side shall complete the technical preparation.

Sandor Andorka/CC Member Refereeing explains the EHF strategy for nominating the selected referees to top matches in EC and CL competitions during the preparatory phase. The National Federations have been informed on the necessity for nominating the EHF Euro referees to top matches in their national competitions prior to the 2012 EHF Euro in SRB.
