EHF OPENING & CLOSING

Leopold Kalin /EHF CC Chairman opens the seminar by referring to the EHF policy of nominating EHF EURO Event referees, starting with a "kick-off" seminar at the beginning of a 4 month preparatory cycle. EHF CAN will provide facilities to optimize the physical preparation as well as the mental coaching and guidance during the tournament. Expertise from the coaches' side shall complete the technical preparation.
