Procedures before, during and after the match

AT HOME, BEFORE TRAVEL TO MATCH

- Prepare physically and mentally for the forthcoming match;
- Analyse both teams (their playing style, mentality, videos if available, previous seasons/objectives);
- Communicate with home team/federation and EHF Delegate/s;
- Confirm travel schedule with each other and host representatives, well in advance.

Find about local culture and the city visiting

DAY BEFORE THE MATCH

- Arrive at venue;
- Have meeting with EHF Delegate/s;
- Have the technical meeting;
- Have initial inspection of the hall;
- Have any other necessary discussions with your partner and EHF Delegate/s;
- Prepare and give undivided attention to the coming match.

MATCH DAY

FORGET HANDBALL AND KEEP MIND FRESH UNTIL ARRIVAL AT THE VENUE!!!

- Arrive at the venue at least 1 hour 15 minutes before the match;
- Talk with table officials, floor manager and any other key persons...
- Prepare for the match;
- Warm up;
- Final communication with players, team officials, table officials and EHF Delegate/s;
- Coin toss.

DURING THE MATCH

- Try to keep a good and sportsmanlike atmosphere at all times during the match;
- Keep control of the match at all times;
- In co-ordination with the EHF Delegate/s keep control of the benches behaviour;
- Keep contact with your partner, EHF Delegate/s and the table officials throughout the match;
- Keep mental note of yellow cards and suspensions;
- Be fair and impartial at all times;
- Make sure that concentration is constant throughout.

AFTER THE MATCH

THE MATCH IS NOW FINISHED... NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE

- Sign scoresheet;
- Be aware of conversations that each team is having with their coaches... it can be useful feedback from the match;
- Analysis of referee performance with EHF Delegate/s and discussion of any match report needed;
- Discuss about the situations occurred on the match with your partner and the Delegate, not only talk about negatives. Positives and Special situation can also help. IT IS ESSENTIAL TO HAVE CONSTRUCTIVE FEEDBACK AND SELF ANALYSIS FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT!

AT ALL TIMES, REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE A REFEREE!!! IT IS PART OF YOUR LIFE!!!
