What is written in the rules about “Blocking”?

8:1 It is permitted:

- a) to use an open hand to play the ball out of the hand of another player;
- b) to use bent arms to make body contact with an opponent, and to monitor and follow him in this way;
- c) to use one’s trunk to block the opponent, in a struggle for positions;

Comment:

Blocking means, preventing an opponent from moving into open space. Setting the block, maintaining the block and moving out of the block must, in principle, be done in a passive manner in relation to the opponent (see, however, 8:2b).



What is written in the rules about “Blocking”?

8:2 It is not permitted:

b) to block the opponent with arms, hand, legs, or to use any part of the body to displace him or push him away; this includes a dangerous use of the elbow, both as a starting position and in motion;



But don't forget:

Any rule for other fouls described in rules 8:1 – 8:2, usually executed by defenders, are also valid for attackers.

And one more thing, everybody have the same possibilities and rights on the field.



Advice pivot play

The referee must show the line from the start off the match, otherwise it can be very difficult to keep the control around the 6 m line!

When a pivot have a hard shot inside the goal-post normally nothing!
If possibly see what happened before the action



Challenge

- Control from start, who make the first action
- Correct or not correct blocking
- 1:1 around Goal area
- Timing of let the pivot go
- Effect must be visible
- Inside Goal area
- Control/holding in shirt
- Control/special behaviour pivot/defender





Both players inside 6 meter. Must be free throw and progressive for defender



Small contact from the defender in the beginning, afterwards acting from both players. Good decision from the referees. Verbal warming for both players because of acting

Clear pushing from defender can not be GKT must be free throw for the attacker



Offensive foul. Pivot intentionally pushes back with his body the defender

**Free throw plus 2 min. for the defender.
Never attacker foul**



**Acting from the pivot defender tried to
pull his shirt without any success and
after that pivot acts like he was pulled
down in order to provoke 2 min.**

There is no 2 min for the defender vary clear back pushing from the pivot must be given offensive foul



No acting from pivot vary clear hitting with body from the defender. Must be progressive

**No chance for 2 min. for the defender.
Clear jumping-acting from pivot side**



**Free throw for the attacker but must be
progressive for the defender**

Seriously unsportsmanlike conduct from GK must be RED card no acting from the pivot

Pivot play - fouls against pivot
Norway vs Austria

In the beginning of the action GKT has to be given. In next action offensive foul – never free throw

Clear pushing – pulling down from the defender it must be 2 min

**Must be offensive foul no free throw.
Clear pushing with the back from the pivot**

God decision from the referees just a small pushing from defender and then clear acting from the pivot

Russia vs Iceland

Play on vary clear acting from the pivot when he felt down. After he realised that he can not catch the ball

**In the beginning of the action vary clear pushing from the defender. Advantage was given and after the acting from the attacker free throw can not be given.

Russia vs Iceland

Can not be 2 min. Small contact between defender and attacker and then clear jumping from pivot

Must be 7m. The ball is rolling in the 6m and attacker is waiting on the 6m line, when the defender jumps on purpose and hits the ball in the corner

Norway vs Denmark

Can not be offensive must be free throw and progressive for the defender

Offensive is OK, pivot push from the behind and afterwards clear acting from his side

Russia vs Austria

Can not be 2 min. Just small contact from defender and then clear acting from attacker

Russia vs Austria

No free throw for the attacker in the beginning attacker is clear in 6m line and push the defender from behind. In second action clear acting from attacker

Spain vs Germany

No chance for giving 2min for the defender. Clear acting from the attacker

Denmark vs Spain

Clear acting from the attacker. He jumps intentionally on a side like he is pushed away. Only small contact from the defender



Play on. No free throw, no 2 min. Clear acting from the attacker

Poland vs Iceland

Only free throw. Short holding and then he raised his hands up (not possible 2 min)
