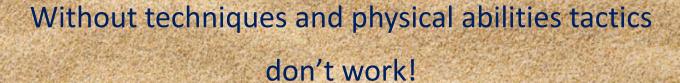

4 phases of the game

- Defence
- Fast break
- Offence
- Quick retreat
- (Shot out)





Defence

Numerical inferiority

Anticipation

- Aims of defence (vs. indoor)
 to stop or interfere with the scoring of a 2-point goal
 to prevent with the scoring of goal

Order of defence

- to prevent the easiest way of scoring a goal substitution
- general defence

Aim of defence (vs. indoor)

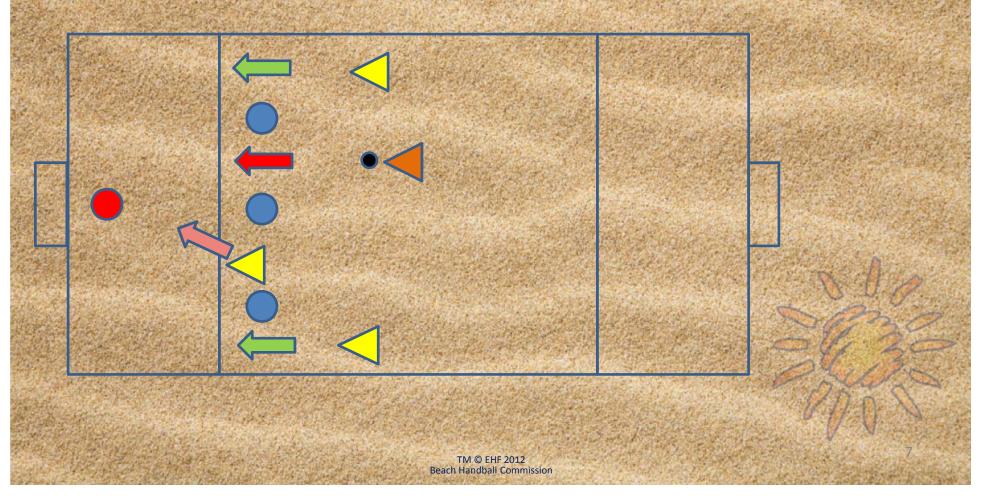
- 1. to stop or interfere with the scoring of a 2-point goal
- goalkeeper direct goal specialist inflight or spin shot

- 2. to prevent scoring a goal
- defence



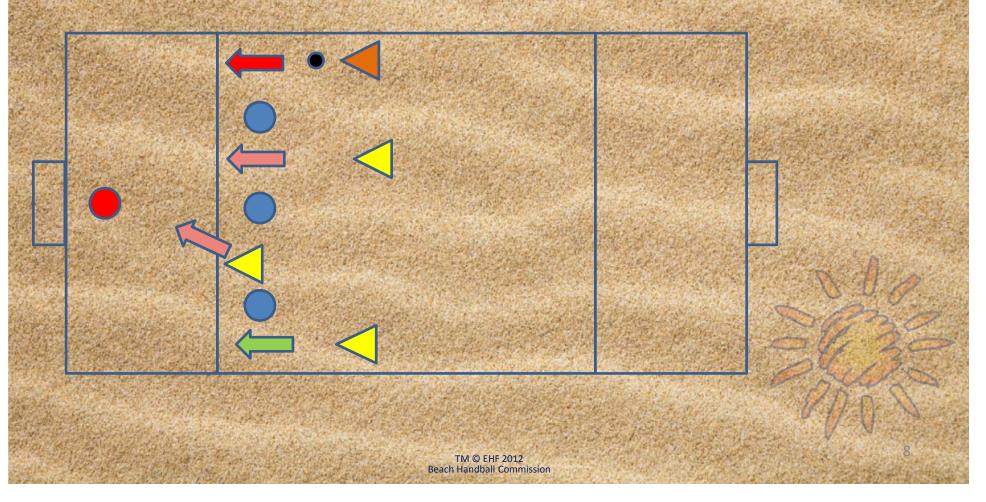


Threat order – view of scoring 2 points

Basic defence startegy

- to play 3 against 4
- there is one attacker (specialist) who can score 2 points with any kind of shots
- the main aim is to try to stop the scoring of a 2- point goals

The basic positions and movements depend on the specialist, pivot and the ball positions.

- to force the offence into 1 against 1 situations
- 3 against 4 situations require more legwork for the defense, because they are at a disadvantage and cannot defend as closely



Basic defence startegy

Teaching basic defence strategy:

- Special defence techniques to block spin shot (diving block)
- Create different situation anticipations
- Create different situations to attend threat order
- Create different situations for traps

- Individual fast break
- Extended fast break
- Complete fast break





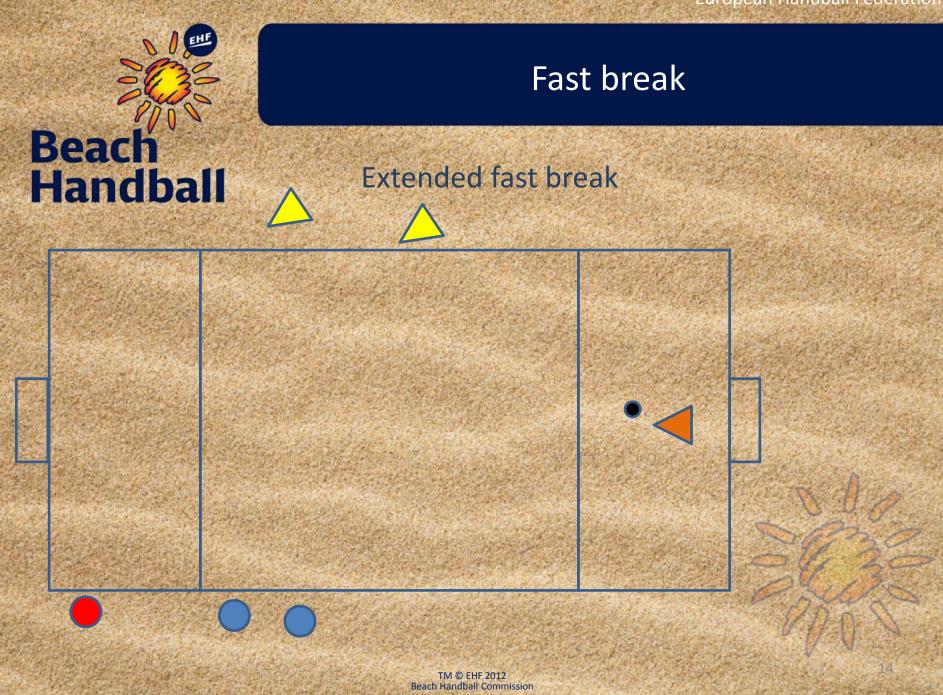

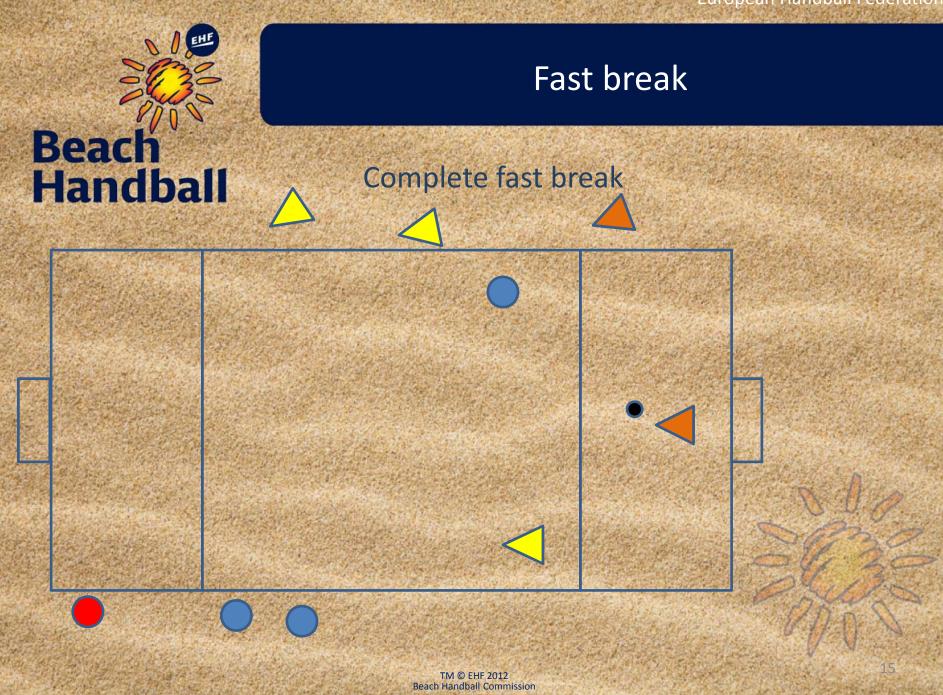

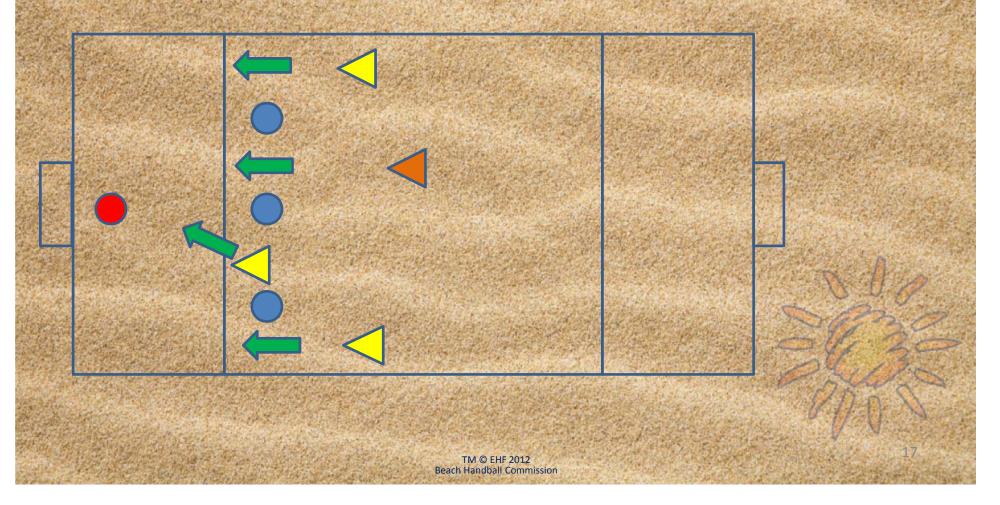


Aim of offence (vs. indoor)

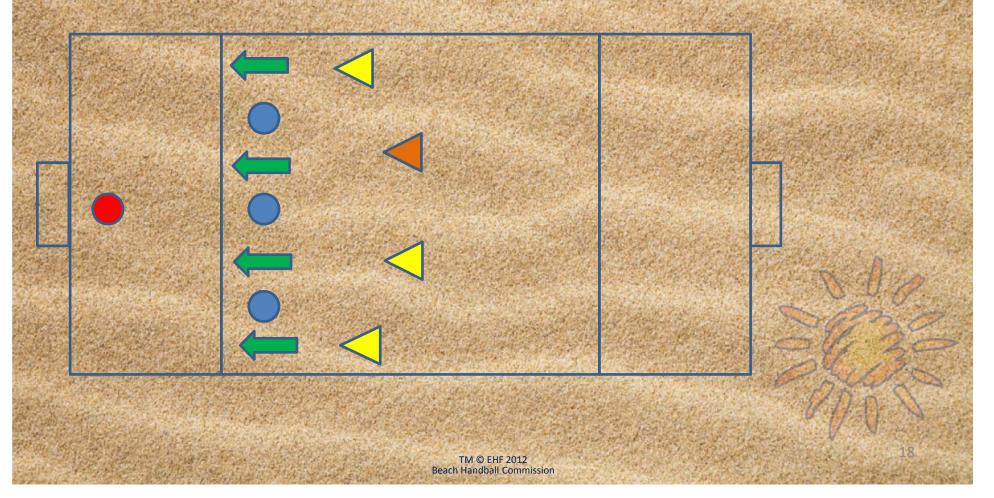
- scoring of a 2-point goal
- goalkeeper direct goal
- specialist inflight or spin shot
- scoring of goal
- depends on strategy



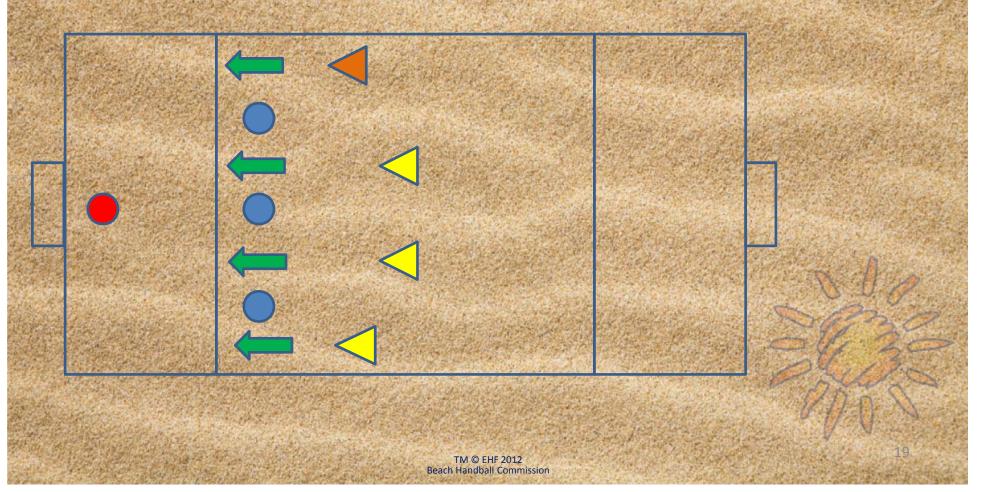














- The effeciency of the team strongly depends on the movements without the ball. (Permanent pressure for the defenders, speed before the shot.)
- During all of the trainings the coaches have to force the players to learn the right movements (direction and distance).
- The movements require special physical stamina/endurance, because to start and change direction with adequate speed is more difficult than on a firm surface.
- Basic movements are very important because they prepare and define the opportunities for and the quality of the shots.



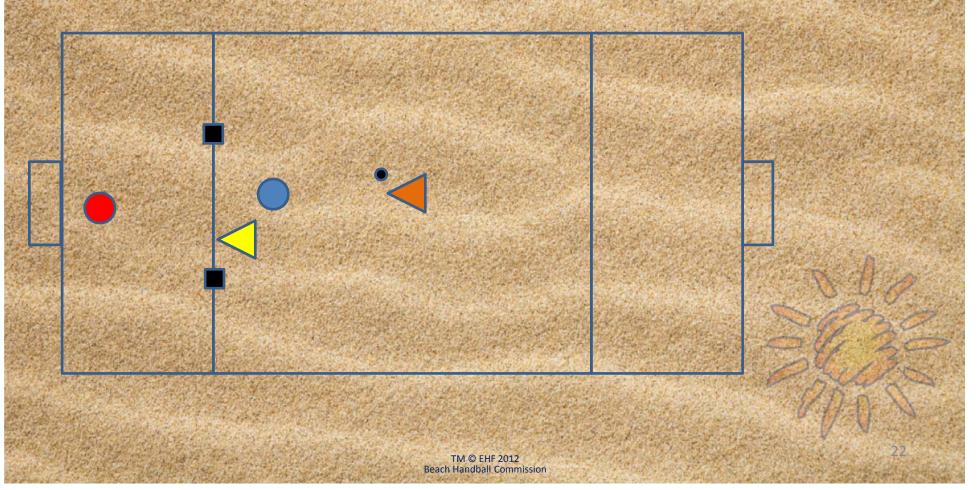
Teaching attack tactics:

- 2 against 1 (focusing on decision maker)
- 3 against 2 (all alternatives)
- 4 against 3 (looking for all solutions with active defenders)

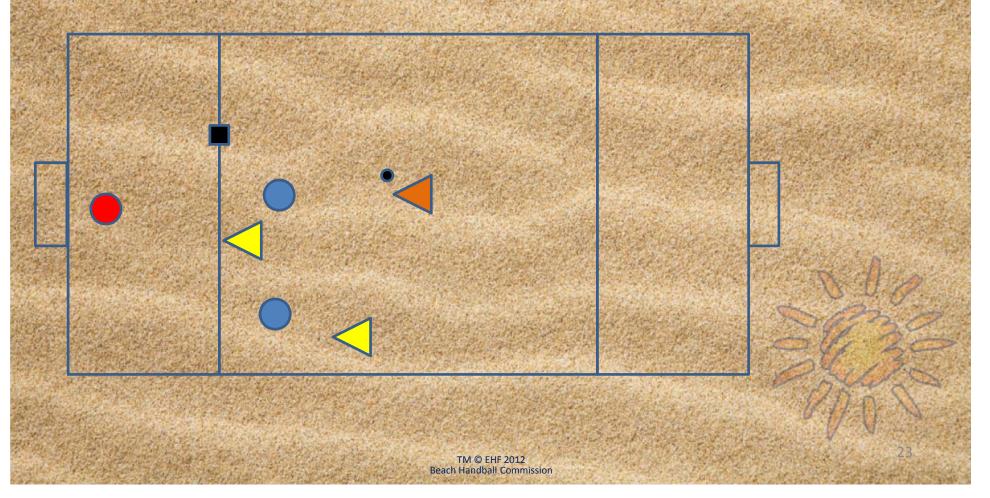




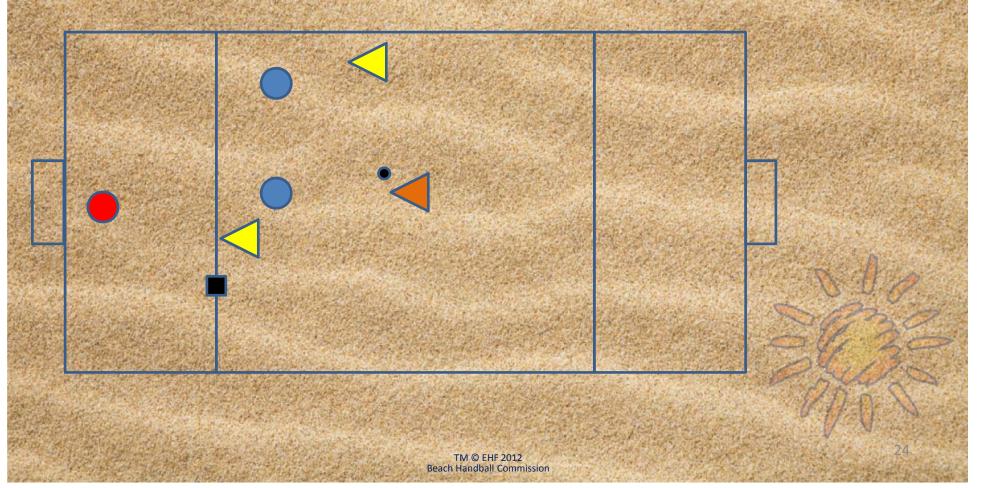














Quick retreat

Order of quick retreat:

- Prevent goalkeeper dircet goal
- Substitute as fast as possible
- Prevent any kind of fast break
