# CHARACTERISTICS OFFENSIVE PLAY

- The average number of fastbreak per match was 6,7.
- At the EURO 2014 it was 4,8 per match.
- NED had the most fastbreaks (11,7 per match); total of 82-105 (9 matches).
- At the EURO 2014 it was POL and RUS who had the most fastbreaks; both 6,3 per match.



# CHARACTERISTICS OFFENSIVE PLAY

- The number of successful fast breaks show a slight increase, which is a result of better transition to attack. At the EURO 2014 it was 4,8 per match.
- Quick throw-offs were used by all teams, with varying success.





# CHARACTERISTICS OFFENSIVE PLAY

- The average number of breakthrough per match was 4.
- At the EURO 2014 it was 4,4 per match.
- POL had the most breakthroughs (2,7 per match); total of 23-24 (9 matches).
- At the EURO 2014 it was NOR who had the most fastbreaks; 7 per match – total 56 (8 matches).



# CHARACTERISTICS OFFENSIVE PLAY

- The average number of assists per match was 15,4.
- NED had the most assists (20,7 per match); total of 186 (9 matches).
- The average number of technical faults per match was 11,9.
- POL make the most technical faults (13,7 per match); total of 124.

# CHARACTERISTICS

## STEALS AND BLOCKS

- On average the 2 teams of a match stole the ball 3,6 times and blocked 2,6 times.
- In 2014 the average was 9 steals and 6 blocks.
- NED had the most steals (5,5 per match) and most blocks (5 per match) followed by FRA (4,6 steals per match) and RUS (3,3 blocks per match).



# CHARACTERISTICS

## STEALS AND BLOCKS

- The number of steals and blocks depend on the defensive system, on the height of the players and on the experience and anticipation skill of the players.
- In steals and blocks the teams of NED, RUS (40 steals/30 blocks) and FRA (41 steals/23 blocks) performed well, while MNE (32 steals/7 blocks) was poor.



# CHARACTERISTICS SUSPENSIONS

- In 2015 the referees gave 291 times 2 minutes suspension to the top 8 EURO teams.
- During the entire tournament 7 red cards were given to the top 8 EURO teams.
- The largest number of suspensions were given against MNE (44) and RUS (41).



# CHARACTERISTICS SUSPENSIONS

- From the top 8 EURO teams NED would receive the Fair-Play award, with only 28 times of 2 minutes suspensions in the tournament.
- MNE had extremely large number of suspensions: 44 times in 9 matches, which means 4,9 suspensions per match in average.

# TEAM CHARACTERISTICS

Norway	Netherlands
- 6:0 defence	- 6:0 defence
- Anticipation in defence	- Sometimes combined defence 5+1 with a player more
- Players are very well skilled and tactical very strong	- Classical tactic in attack vs. Set zone defence
- Less distance shooters	- Good movements
- Very good pivot and good collaboration with pivot	- Fast play incl. CA and fast throw-off
- Fast play incl. CA	



# TEAM CHARACTERISTICS

Romania	Poland
- 6:0 defence	- 6:0 defence
- Body and ball oriented defence	- Sometimes combined defence 5+1 and individual defence
- Defence – attack change one or more players	- Strong players and rough in body contacts
- Physically very strong and tall players	- Good distance shooters
- Many crossing actions and changing positions in attack	- Low shoot efficiency
- Good distance shooters	- Good in breakthrough situations
- Fast play but a lot of technical mistakes	- Fast play but a lot of technical mistakes



# TEAM CHARACTERISTICS

Russia	Denmark
- 6:0 and 5:1 defence	- 6:0 defence
- 5+1 combined defence with player advantage	- Defence – attack change of player
- Body and ball oriented defence	- Crossing and changing positions
- Physically very strong and tall players	- Good distance shooters
- Many crossing actions in attack	- Fast play, CA and fast throw-off but a lot of technical mistakes
- Good distance shooters	
- Fast play but a lot of technical mistakes	



# TEAM CHARACTERISTICS

France	Montenegro
- 6:0 and 5:1 defence	- 6:0 defence
- Ball oriented defence	- Strong players and rough in body contacts
- Excellent individual CA	- Good distance shooters
- Good distance shooters	- Good wing and pivot players
- Too individual play, less tactic	- Tactically strong
	- Good team attack concepts with individual solutions



# GENERAL OBSERVATION

- Top EURO teams use 6:0 defence.
- Sometimes change in case of woman advantage
- A few changes of defence system during the game
- Defence specialists almost in all teams, standing on the important positions.



# GENERAL OBSERVATION

- Quick return in organised defence
- An excellent goalkeeper can make the difference between win or loose.
- Collaboration between goalkeeper and defenders is getting better and better
