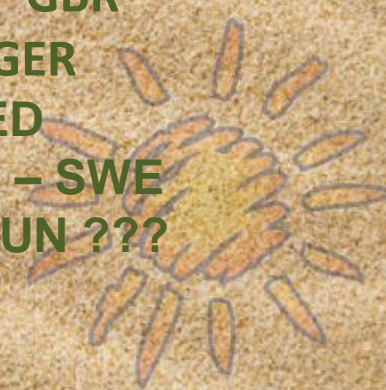

Home assignments

Themes for home assignments. (ebt Final)

- **Theme 1: Progressive line, punishments, red cards. (POR)**
- **Theme 2: 6m situations (ESP)**
- **Theme 3: Shoot outs (SLO)**
- **Theme 4: Spectacular goals: Spin shots and in flights. (GRE)**
- **Theme 5: Defense activities, block - offensive faults, passive play. (CRO)**
- **Theme 6: Long term performance + match preparations + passive play (GER)**





Beach Handball

Clarifications I.

- 10 players eligible to play
- Direct red card results in immediate one-match suspension.
- A direct red card with report leads to a DC decision.
- Exclusion is no more part of the punishments.





Clarifications II.

Beach Handball

- Goal area violation by an offensive player: The game is restarted with a goalkeeper throw.

- Own goal: An own goal scored by any player is awarded as a one-point goal to the opposition team.





Beach Handball

Clarifications III.

- **Choosing method:** Rock - Paper – Scissors will be used
- **Shoot-out draw:** Drawing lots between the teams shall decide the ends and the team throwing first or last. The team winning the draw may choose whether it wishes to throw first or last OR the defending end. If the draw-winning team decide to choose ends, then the other team may chose whether it wishes to throw first or last.

Tendencies and our reactions

- Influence in indoor – higher number of in-flight, numerical superiority, etc...
- Short seasons but fast responses
- Our job is to react if necessary
- Do it together in one line!
- A good common line prevents confusion...
... and results in respect. CL is all teams need!
- The key is teamwork





Communication

- Important tool
 - ❖ Use your personality and communicate
 - ❖ non verbal and verbal
 - ❖ NV: gestures, signals, etc...

Behaviour and Smartness

- Leadership and be part of the game
 - ❖ Be present from the beginning (First seconds)
 - ❖ Live together with the match
 - ❖ Show the progressivity
 - ❖ Show confidence
- Be consistent in your calls till the last minute.





Beach Handball

Prevention and advantage

- Be smart and prevent tough situation
- But use advantage when you can!
- Respect the flow of the game
- Read the game
- ❖ The CORRECT use of advantage makes a good referee a great referee.





Beach Handball

Spectacular goals: Spin shots and in flights

- Spectacular
 - Something that you haven't yet seen and is truly amazing.
- In flight
 - ❖ In air
 - ❖ Ball controll
- Spins
 - ❖ No easy 2 pointers. (Start, full spin, landing)

Game management

- Starts before (Show that you are there)
 - ❖ Warming up, pre match tasks, friendly but confident
- During the match
 - ❖ Moving around, build up your lines, control the court...
 - ❖ ... And the substitution area too (1 official moving, only bottles, help the teams in substitutions but if clear mistake then suspension)
- After
 - ❖ Shake hands, but NEVER discuss





Beach Handball

Shoot outs

- Teams, coaches are often nervous. Show confidence, keep order, guide them.
- Good task distribution! Who is watching what!
 - ❖ GK throw – watch the goal line.
 - ❖ Run with the player. Position!
 - ❖ Control the spin and the goal line.
- GK behavior.





Beach Handball

- Block
 - ❖ Safe distance. No collision before the throw. Danger vs excellent defence.





Beach Handball

Defense activities, block - offensive faults, passive play

- Offensive Fault
 - ❖ The defense player should be stationary.
 - ❖ When both moving the first taking position must be observed.
- Passive play
 - ❖ Have a line. Attacking team must attack on goal. Correct use of the warning signal. Shorter time, but give a chance for build up.
