- Good physical preparation

- Good relationship with your partner

How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?

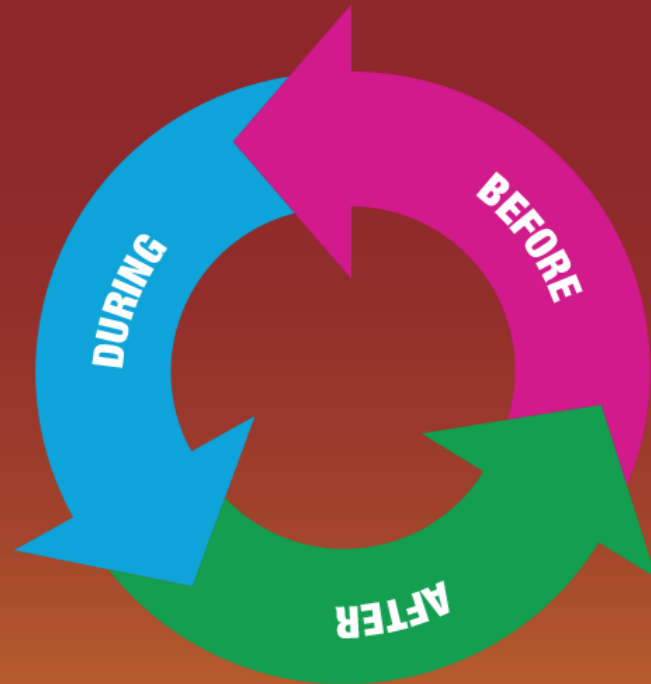
➤ Referees tasks:

- Equal authority, they should respect their own duties and each other
- Responsible for everything what happens on the court, before, during and after the match
- Responsible for inspecting the court, the goals and the ball, check the score sheet, the equipment of the players before the match



How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?

- *Before the game*
- *During the game*
- *After the game*





How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?

➤ *Before the game*

- ✓ Be in time at the court
- ✓ Say "Hello" to the delegate, team officials, time/scorekeeper
- ✓ Warm up (get used with the sunlight, temperature, atmosphere)
- ✓ Coin toss and ask the teams to play fair
- ✓ Shake hands with the players and officials



How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?





How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?

- *During the game*
 - ✓ Clear body language in every situation
 - ✓ Focus at the game starting from the first second
 - ✓ Good and clear progressive line
 - ✓ Good cooperation with the delegates, time/scorekeeper
 - ✓ Look nice and smile!



How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?





How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?

➤ *After the game*

- ✓ Shake hand with your partner, officials and players that come to you
- ✓ Take care of the match report
- ✓ Analyze the game with your partner, then with the delegate
- ✓ Talk with the players and/or officials about special events that happened during the game, if they ask you to

How to manage a game well, with positive attitude?





Which are the characteristics of a good referees?

- Cleverness
- Good knowledge of the rules
- Confidence
- Perseverance
- Positive attitude
- Clear line
- Good advantage
- Stay fit







What does the advantage means?

- A clause in the Rules of the Game that gives the referees the discretion to allow play to continue even after a foul has been committed if stopping play would unfairly punish the fouled team
 - Look for advantage and if this doesn't appear, you can whistle later
 - Respect the flow of the game, but never tolerate an advantage taken by violating the rules



How to apply the "advantage" correctly in BH?

- Be as „invisible“ as possible in the game! 
- Be present, but whistle only if it's necessary!
- "feeling the game"- read the game, express your understanding of the game
- Express your leadership with clear line- same for both side. If you have a clear line from the beginning of the game, everybody will know what you allow and what not- take care that the game runs smoothly 

We are in the game to EXPRESS, not to IMPRESS!
