Let's start.....

Picking up the match report/laptop in the CPO is the first step of your job in a match, remember to take a raw copy for yourself.

The playing court is now your home: it has to be free from any objects

## Table.....

Checking the secretary table will be as well important: reserve clock, suspension cards, whistle, TTO cards (to be delivered to team officials).....



## Relation with teams:

- Is very important during the warming up of the teams to have an informal speech with officials of the teams in order to clear out in a friendly way what will be allowed and what not.
- Remember to check before the match that all area has to be cleared by any items like flippers, balls, bags and so on, and ask for the help of the officials of the teams in this job.
- Try to be in touch with the match, particularly in situations like the request of "TTO" from the team situated on the opposite substitution area, is important to feel the situations in which bigger attention is needed.
- Before whistling for a suspension to the officials for an unsportsmanlike behavior try to solve with verbal advice, remembering that there will be of course a difference of treatment between the team in the same line of substitution area with the table and the team on the opposite side.

## Relation with timekeeper/secretary:

- These guys act under very big pressure, particularly in the first days, so a calm and friendly behavior is needed to help their job, as it is important to repeat to them the points of each scoring situation and possibly the number of player, acting in this way will be very helpful in the effort to avoid mistakes in scoring.
- It will be very useful to write down our own raw copy of a match report, so we may keep controlled in any time the situation.
- Keep controlled the correct execution of the whistle for the end match and the correct stopping of the time during all "TTO" procedures.
- Every delegate must have a whistle and a stopwatch, as well as the secretary.

## Relation with referees:

- Keep in mind that we are just a "help" for them and not "chief referees", and act consequently.
- A conversation before the match is needed with a review of all the duties and for creating a "team" cooperation altogether.
- If we have the sensation that they are "losing the line" during the match try with "eye contact" to give them support and help to be more self-confident and regain the line of the match.
- If we have the possibility in the interval of the two halves, speak again with them maybe about a couple of unclear situations, without interfering but simply try to drive their attention in the facts that have to be defined in a better way in the coming out of the match.
- At the end of a nervous match enter the court just after the end and congratulate with them and with teams, trying to come back to a "fair play" situation even if we think that they did really a bad job.....we will have time later separately to discuss with them our conclusions and our point of view about their performance.

### REMINDER FOR DELEGATES

Dear Beach Handball friends, the Champs are coming, important tasks wait for us, therefore, we want to remind you the following, in order to create the best possible picture for our sport:

- Leaning on banners is not allowed.
- Warming up without playing kits is not allowed.
- All four officials must wear identical shirts, if not they will not be allowed to enter the court, goes without saying that the color has to be different than opponent's playing kits color.
- Banners and advertising on the courts have to be totally free from everything: towels, shirts etc. , on the court only bottles and medical bags may stay.
- Delegates and officials do not have to wear accreditations during matches
- During TTO only the officials on the court may participate
- All players in the substitution area must kneel or sit , as well as the second official
- During shootout the teams must be close to the defensive goal and kneel or sit, only one GK is anyway allowed on the court.
- During Golden Goal no TTO is allowed
- During shoot-out, until outcome of the match is not decided, after every serie of five shots, sides and order of shooters must be changed
- During shoot-out, suspensions are not allowed, only red card (disqualification) can be given in case of unsportsmanlike behavior either to officials or players
- In KO matches when the outcome of the match has been decided, the shoot-out is over

# Beach Handball

## How to manage a protest.....

- Protests shall be announced to the EHF delegate orally after the end of the match and he must indicate exact time on MR
- The reason of the protest shall be handed over in writing within 30 min after the end of the match. At the same time a protest fee of 400€ has to be paid. If the protest is accepted the deposit will be refunded.
- The EHF Disciplinary Commission takes its decision by a simple majority 1h before the start of the next match of the team concerned
