# Offensive fouls



## 1. The defender's position:

- **Correct:** blocking of open space
- **Incorrect:**
  - the defender intervenes from side - timing!
  - the defender move forward to close the open space

# Offensive fouls

2. The defender behaviour  
when body contact made:

- frontal contact
- "last seconds" movement forward
- pushing , holding , restraining - without ball too !
- **protection of body** - the attacker with full speed/energy

## 3. Timing :

- important - good handball understanding
- who reached the "meeting point" first
- defender must be not stationary fouls without ball ! Strategy !

## 4. Typical offensive fouls situations :

- 1:1
- Moving sideways -offensive fouls by shoulder
- Offensive fouls without ball
