Topic 1 – The EHF Event Manager / Delegate's Profile

- The system of EHF concerning travel and accommodation in EHF Cups is ok – does not need any changes.
- Professionals versus volunteers: the group proposes a long-term project containing more money > semi-professionals > could lead to professional referees and delegates
- More contacts between referees/delegates and teams are recommended
- The system of referee/delegate nominations should be kept (UEFA system is not suitable for EHF)
- Current status of EHF concerning contacts of referees and delegates to the media is ok (after the match or prior to the match)

Topic 2 – EHF Referee Profile – Referee of the future

- Point system for the referees should be restructured: A combination of point system and evaluation in writing depending on the level of the match respectively of the level of the referees. Additionally own referee observer are recommended.
- Referee exchange programme on demand of the National Federations and distribution of referees nominated for the next EHF top event should be nominated in diverse international matches by EHF
- The mentor system for young referees is recommended
- The best referees for the best matches – EHF TOP EVENTS ARE NOT TRAINING CAMPS

Topic 3 – Cooperation Referees – Delegates

- Again: more contacts and information between players / coaches and referees / delegates are recommended

Topic 4 – Education and Further Training of Refs/Del in the future

- More exchange of information concerning education and further education for referees and delegates between EHF and National Federations is recommended

Topic 5 – Trend Analysis of the Game / Refereeing

- Due to the fact that only information on the new rules has been presented no discussion followed



Topic 6 – Referees/Delegates in Basketball

- Administrative tasks like time-keeping and score-taking should be transferred to the time keeping table in order to enable the referees to have more capacities for leading the game
- the group recommends to keep the couple system in handball but the door for experiments concerning single referees should be open
 - examinations, education and further education should be obligatory for the future
