Where and who

A unique game that can be played in:

- schoolyards
- parks
- town squares

Everywhere...

A unique game that can be played by:

everybody without consideration of

- gender
- age
- skills

And everyone can play together









Why

What makes the game so great for everybody

- The matches can be played **unorganized**
- 4:3 in the field gives the attacking team the advantage
- The goal area line is easier to handle and it plays a smaller role
- The ball is easier to handle
- Focus is on the experience,

.....not primarily on winning









The Values

A Game Based on Social Values:

Communication Teamwork Respect Fair play

Street Handball should encourage **social responsibility.**

Focus on Creating 'the good experience' more winners than losers.









The Ball

Special Ball

Newly developed "Street Handball" ball (cooperation between SHO and Select)

The ball is:

- soft
- easy to handle
- has the feeling of a 'real' handball

No further equipment is necessarily required - However goals and lines are also available

A new Street Game is born... Consequences for EHF and Follow-up

Quotation by Lasse Boesen who has played more than 100 matches for the Danish Handball National Team, winning the EHF Euro gold medal in 2008:
