- Countries are putting referees on the YRP-list too "early". It takes too many years before they get the possibility to take part in a continental candidates course.
- The persons taking care of the YRP-referees in different countries should get better education and support from EHF.
- The standard of the referees from this project is very various depending of which country they are coming from.
- A special group of delegates (Tutors) should take care of young referees and follow up them during 1-2 years.



EDUCATION GUIDELINE BOOK

- Same education in all countries in all categories, not only on top level.
- EHF lecturer should educate persons who are educating national referees in European countries.
- Good way of getting better referees in different countries and with almost same quality.
- In the guideline book it is important to clearly describe the skills you should have in different stages during your career from beginner to top level referee.

FEMALE PROJECT-OFFICIATING BY

- In all other big sports like football, icehockey, floorball etc., female championships are officiated by females.
- Female referees should have the same possibility to improve their skills as males. Female referees should also referee male matches, at least junior and youth matches.
- For the moment it is not possible to carry out championships only using female referees and officials. We do not have enough qualified persons today, but if we decide to have it as a goal, I think we can reach it very soon. The other question is, should there be only women?
