Summary of Coaching Topics for the Future

(presented by Carlos Garcia/POR/EHF Lecturer)

Proposals:

- 1) Reduction of the number of players
 - more space means more technical/tactical possibilities
 - handball must be an attractive game, easy to understand for the spectators
- 2) Technical/tactical elements
 - methodological/didactical/pedagogical philosophy on "how to play defence"
 - we want a fast, physical but fair game
 - create a philosophy/a pedagogical concept for teaching defence after asking the national federations
 - focus on playing the ball/ "trap ball defence" (provoking opponent to make faults)
- 3) Playing time of 3 x 20 minutes
- 4) Focus on coaches' education
 - reserve some time to discuss emotions
 - communication between coaches rferees and delegates
- 5) EHF Lecturer staff
 - regular seminars, exchange of opinion in the future
 - "virtual" seminars, use of new media

Summary of Refereeing Topics for the Future

(presented by Mona Förström/FIN/EHF Lecturer)

Proposals:

- 1) 2011 EHF Guidelines for Referee Education on EHF and National Level
 - excellent teaching tool for EHF and National Federations
 - regular updates concerning practical training/exercises necessary
 - more emphasis on referee delegate cooperation
 - more emphasis on referee coach delegate communication
- 2) Female referees
 - female referees shall also referee men's competitions
 - no women's competitions refereed by female referees only

- referee performance criteria shall apply for both genders
- in some countries female referees do not get equal chances
- mentoring system to be introduced and applied on EHF and national level
- 3) Young Referee Programme (YRP)
 - EHF YRP coordination on a good way
 - Mentoring system to be applied in the YRP
- 4) Rule development
 - simpler rules
 - less clarifications, shorter but clear wording
 - coaches' input very important
- 6) Handball and media
 - guidelines to be elaborated on how to cooperate and handle the media

Summary of Beach Handball Topics for the Future

(presented by Sinisa Ostoic/CRO/EHF Lecturer)

Game design:

- 2 pointer: new attractive solutions to be created by the players
 - o Group tactic: in-flight
 - Single: spin shot
 - o ...
- Mixed teams: mainly for promotion games; up to the age of 12 years mixed, boys and girls teams for competitions compare Minihandball; competitions for mixed teams could be taken as a new initiative
- Role of the goalkeeper: only when the was goalkeeper in the defence before in case this idea could be taken into consideration it has to be implemented into the IHF BH Rules of the Game; so far it is the decision of the coaches; in case the GK will not be switched with a specialist the speed of the game will increase – could be a future development in BH to create players who will have the respective skills for both roles.
- Benefits of BH for indoor Handball: to be listed (+arguments) for players and referees in order to strengthen the value of BH

Officiating:

- Rules:
 - \circ $\;$ Rules shall not be changed again in the near future
 - To adapt some BH rules to indoor rules
 - Charging fouls and pushing could cause problems in the future clear guidelines to be needed – in progress
