“Spirit of Beach Handball”



- Philosophy of FAIR PLAY
- Respect the health, integrity and body of the players
- Respect the spirit and philosophy of the game
- More spectacular actions
- Less physical contact





Criteria to evaluate the intensity of a foul

- Position: front – side – back
- Speed: full speed – slow moving
- Body part: arm – leg – neck – face – head
- Fouls inflight!
- Preparation of the opponent (GK out of area)





Punishments



- Verbal warning
- Suspension
- Disqualification
- Exclusion





Verbal warning

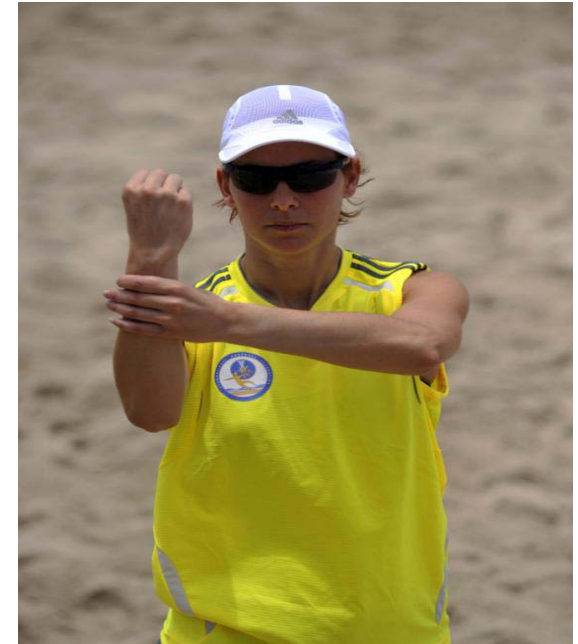
- First step of progressive punishment
- At the beginning of the game
- Clear but not provocative
- Used for accidents and fouls without strong intensity





Suspension

- Repeated fouls
- Repeated unsportsmanlike conduct
- Holding, pushing, running into opponent
- Not putting down the ball after a decision against





Disqualification

- 2nd Suspension of a player
- Serious unsportsmanlike conduct
- Fouls which endanger opponents health
- Fouls of GK leaving goal in Shootout
- Assault by a player outside the playing time
- Assault by a team official
- Must be explained by the referees in match report





Exclusion

- Assault by a player during the playing time
- Always for the entire remainder of the game!
- Must be explained by referees in match report





Tips for following the progressive line



- Verbal & non-verbal communication
- Clear sound of whistle
- Move into situation
- Follow the progressive line from first to last minute
- Same treatment in same situations for both teams
