Mopping Concept




ORT

- Pro-active, preventive mopping strategy
- 4 person mopping crew positioned in each playing court corner
- Standard mopping actions after the end of on-court warm-up before pre-match procedure, during half-time and time-out /team time-out decisions
- Preventive mopping actions during play after turnover situations based on referee signal (not in fast break situation)



Interview Backdrops – teams cannot use their own backdrops for interview in the arena / training hall and hotel (unless in a room booked for a team press conference)



Open Training Sessions



- Training sessions that take place within the competition hall will be open to television crews and photographers for 10 minutes at the beginning of the session for the purpose of filming/photography
- Teams have the option to keep the remainder of the session open to the media, or to ask the media to leave
- The Local Media Manager is responsible for overseeing the open training sessions, ensuring that the media remain in the area designated to them, do not disturb the players and leave when requested to do so
- The media are not permitted to conduct interviews unless the team officials allow this



Flash & Mixed Zone



- Basic Information & Background
- Pre-defined exits to be used after the match
- All interviews in front of Backdrops
- It is obligatory for the entire delegation to pass through the Flash & Mixed Zone after the game (except doctors, physiotherapists)




