
1. Hollywood- playacting -fake actions

 - after the short treatment the player ready to play!




4. Meaning of acting / Hollywood actions

 the main goal mislead the referees and create advantage for own team





5. Kind of provocative behaviour

 immobilization of opponent player and create more harder foul by the opponent

 the player is falling down, seem serious injury, not interruption by the referees and the player

against ready to play in defence

 provoked offensive fouls -very limited contact and falling down



- verbal actions complaining/provocation on the opponent player
- behaviour of substitution area team-officials
