



Cooperation between back court players

- Back players playing is the most important part of handball game
- We have three back court players but every combination, every cooperation is between two of them
- There are a lot of possibilities for cooperation
- First one is <u>run-up</u> what is basic cooperation between back players
- Let's now analize position of back player






- To use these possibilities back player has to know 7 different kind of movements (run-up) to goal (3 kinds of lateral run-up; 2 kinds of frontal run up; run-up for jump shoot and normal running)
- Also, technique of coming back at basic position is very important
- Tactical details are: don't expected ball at place, avoid foul, to be "dangerous" after runup, don't use "forth step", pass good ball at right moment....

 The next step in back players cooperation is changing of position


We have two types of changing of position:
<u>cross</u> and <u>contra cross</u>

Let's go to analyze them


Cross of central back player




Cross of back player (tactical wrong)




Cross of back player (tactical well)





Conclusion:


Three back court players have tactical possibilities to play:

- A lot variations of run-up (343),
- Cross of central back (with and without ball) on the both sides,
- Cross of back player on the both side,
- Contra cross of central beck on the both sides, and
- Contra cross of back player on the both side.




- Also back players have connections with pivot and connections with wings
- One of tactical important possibilities is transition on 6 m line.
- This transition can does back player but also wing player.
- Let's go to see these possibilities:
- Back player use same technique as for cross or contra cross only one of back players goes to 6 m.


Cross of central back player and transition












Entrance of wing, pivot blockade


