





IMPLEMENTATION of the EHF Coaching Licensing as of December 2012

As of December 2012 the EHF has started to issue **2** kinds of EHF Coaching Licences based on the EHF Rinck Convention that have to be recognized in all EHF Rinck Convention Signatories, the

- ➤ EHF PRO Coaching Licence (Validitation period 2013/14 with transition period up to 2016)
- ➤ EHF Coaching Licence (Validitation period to be defined by National Federations)



Coaching licensing system in Poland as of 2013

According to the act of law from 13 June 2013, a sport coach can become everyone, who:

- is minimum 18 years old
- has higher, secondary education
- has a basic knowledge, experience and abilities to become a coach /sport instructor
- has never been sentenced with no further right of appeal for a crime described in the paragraph no.25. (Dz. U. Nr 127, poz. 857, z późn. zm.39)

In this legal state, the only document qualifying to be a handball coach in Poland is a Coaching Licence issued and prolonged by the Polish Handball Federation only.





Current coaching licensing system in Poland

Polish Handball Federation (ZPRP) distinguishes 3 licence-categories for handball coaches:

- 1. Coaching Licence category A Authorizes to lead:
- club teams in all divisions.
- all national teams.
- 2. Coaching Licence category B

Authorizes to lead:


- teams playing in the 2nd division and lower senior divisions
- youth teams
- 3. Coaching Licence category C
 Authorizes to lead teams playing in all the youth classes.

Coaching licences are issued and extended by the ZPRP Sport Director. (Coaching Licence - category C, in consultation with the ZPRP Sport Director, can by issued by the local board.)

Season 2014/15: EC, CL, EURO Quali, EUROs, YAC EChs

EHF Coaching Licence = RINCK Convention Level 3 (approved by EHF Executive Committee in 9/2013)

Later on (???): EHF CL, EUROs → EHF PRO Licence





EHF Coaching Licences related to EHF Competitions as of Season 2014/15

Development Plan and Implementation Guidelines

- 1) MC Information/motivation campaign for RC Non-signatories to become Signatories
- 2) Implementation guidelines for a mandatory EHF Coaching Licensing in all EHF Competitions as of the 2014/15 Season
- 3) Transition period solutions (temporary licences) up to the 2015/16 season
- 4) Cooperation EHF National Federations (NATs) as of the 2014/15 season
- 5) EHF Office administration



EHF Coaching Licences related to EHF Competitions as of Season 2014/15

<u>Transition period solutions(temporary licences)up to the 2015/16 season</u>

Minimum Requirement RC Level 3 (=EHF Coaching License) for Level 3 Signatories and RC Level 2 for Level 2 Signatories (= highest national coaching education)

YAC National Team Competitions Men and Women: temporary licence as of 2014/15 - obligatory as of 2015/16*

*) 1 more year for individual educational update on national level





EHF Coaching Licences related to EHF Competitions as of Season 2014/15

Cooperation EHF – National Federations(NATs)as of the 2014/15 season

Basic principle:

EHF Office requests official confirmation of coaching level of head coaches from NATs when submitting team lists for EHF Competitions (or CV with coaching education data in case of YAC coaches in the transition period).

NATs have to break down the national education level of their head coaches in EHF Competitions to RC Level 3 (or Level 2) and confirm this to EHF. In case of YAC coaches they shall provide coaches CVs to EHF in order to facilitate the issueing of temporary licences






