



#### **HISTORY**

- Beach Handball is a sport that has appeared as an additional sport to indoor handball
- Aim: to stay in shape during the summer break
- 1st tournament San Antonio Beach, Ponza, Italy, 1992.
- 1st ECh Gaeta, Italy, 2000.
- International Beach Handball rules were established at the Congress in 1994. (Harleem, Nizozemska)
- •Beach Handball is played on every continent: Africa, Asia, South America, Australia, Europe

- Fast, attractive, exciting game
- Based on the principles of "Fair Play"
- Attractive musical and dance program (cheerleading shows)
- Side events (promotion of host country, cultural and artistic program, players party)

- ✓ Respect the health and integrity of all participans
- ✓ Respect the spirit an philosophy of the game
- ✓ Respect the flow of the game, but never tolerate violation the Rules of the Game
- √ Promote the spirit of true sportsmanship








#### **RULES OF THE GAME**

- A sand court, a non-slip rubber ball
- 8 players (3+1 goalkeeper, 4 substitutes)
- 2 x 10 minutes, each period needs a winner
   (golden goal, shoot out)
- Atrractive/spectacular goals 2 points
   (in-flight & spin shot goals, goal by goalkeeper,
   6 m throw)







- ✓ Beach Handball training methods improve a
  lot of technical requirements of indoor handball:
- Jumping strenght
- Speed endurance
- Falling techniques
- Speed reaction
- Game Review
- Passing and Throwing









- **✓** Basic Techniques:
- Receiving the ball
- Keeping the ball
- Passing the ball
- Fakes
- Shots





- ✓ Receiving the ball:
- Similar to indoor handball
- The only difference is receiving passes in-flight (with one hand)









- The same as in indoor handball
- The difference is the material of the ball (rubber ball)
- There is a danger of losing the ball during the spin shot or rainy weather







- The same as in indoor handball
- The only difference is to make passes to players who are taking in-flights shot
- No opportunity for bounce passes
- No opportunity for bouncing and dribbling
- You can put down the ball and roll







- Specialist the same as in indoor handball
- Wingers passing fakes
- Pivot passing fakes
- Shoot out shooting fakes







#### ✓ Shots:

- Specialist the same as in indoor handball
- Wingers in-flight shot or spin shot (jump from one or two legs)
- Pivot in-flight shot or spin shot (jump from one or two legs)
- Goalkeeper direct goal





- Individual technique
- One leg jump
- Two legs jump
- Pay attention to position of legs
- Pay attention to defenders block








- ✓ Spin shot:
- Exercise 1
- Without the defending player
- LW/RW passing to S
- LW/RW runs parallel to goal direction
- S passes back to LW/RW




- ✓ Spin shot:
- Exercise 2
- With passive defending player
- •LW/RW passing to S
- LW/RW runs parallel to goal direction
- S passes back to LW/RW


- ✓ Spin shot:
- Exercise 3
- With crossing
- LW on middle position
- S on wing position
- S passes to LW
- LW crosses with S
- S passes back to LW






- ✓ In-flight shot:
- Exercise 1
- Without the defending player
- LW passing to RW
- LW runs parallel a goal direction
- RW plays the inflight pass to LW





- ✓ In-flight shot:
- Exercise 2
- With passive defending players
- LW passing to RW
- LW runs parallel a goal direction
- P is on line position
- RW plays the inflight pass to LW or P




- ✓ In-flight shot:
- Exercise 3
- With crossing
- LW passing to RW on middle position
- S on RW position
- RW crosses with S
- S runs parallel a goal direction
- S plays the inflight pass to LW or P

## **TACTICS**

- ✓ Because of the constant 4:3 situation, goals can be scored easily and quickly
- **✓** The basic tactics content:
- Ability to orientate
- Passing under time preassure
- Spectatular throws
- Changing the position
- Quickly changing the direction







- ✓ Additional content in the process of preparing the players
- ✓ Development and improvement of certain segments of the game in defense
- Development of agility, speed and specific endurance
- Development of cooperation between the players
- Development of players perception and concentration
- Improvement of cooperation with the goalkeeper
- Development accuracy and speed of reaction by goalkeeper





# COMPATIBILITY WITH INDOOR HANDBALL

- ✓ Development and improvement of certain segments of the game in offens (attack)
- Playing 4:3 (one player extra)
- Quick transfer of the ball (impossibility of bouncing the ball)
- Development of cooperation between the players
- Improvement of the speed of ball passing
- Receiving the ball in motion
- Development of coordination

Beach Handball is not a threat to Handball, on the contrary, together they can achieve goals such as:

- ✓ Improvement of the quality of the game
- ✓ Improvement the technicaltactical skills
