




Different defense approach of 3-2-1 and 3-1-2 set defense systems

 <p>3/2/1 "LIBERO"</p>	<p><u>3/2/1 "Libero" style</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ③ moving with the ball, covers LP on ball-side only ② 7-9m (10m) against ball and screening pass to LP on non-ball-side ● 8-10m (12m) against PM, covers centre, screening of pass to LP ① sideways on 6m, coming up to screen pass to wing, "trapping" diagonal passes to wing or backcourt
	<p><u>Full wing trap:</u> Wing with ball faces 1-3 situation, backcourt players are forced to retreat deep-court.</p> <p><u>Full backcourt trap</u> deployed after wing trap: If the backcourt player was forced to receive the ball far in deep-court, he shall be approached after dribbling, still on 11m. Diagonal pass shall be offered and trapped in fast counter movement.</p>
 <p>3/1/2</p>	<p><u>3/1/2 "Libero" style</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ③ "Libero" moving with the ball, covering LP on ball-side. ② approach 8-10m (11m) against ball. ● sideways movement on 7-8m, full screen of central area. If ball with PM - approach to 9m max. ① sideways movement only, cover LP on non-ball-side.

The 3-1-2 system offers a much better positioning in the central area of the defense and therefore very little space for the lineplayer of the offense team.

Because of the tighter formation in the centre there is much less danger in case of diagonal transition of the backcourt players to a 4-2 set play.
