Submission Guidelines for the Theses

The thesis should contain 15 to 20 pages including all the images and tables. All text shall be written using the Program MS Word for Windows 6.0 or more recent. Types shall be Times New Roman, 12-point, single-spaced, justified. Images, tables and figures may be included made with MS Word and/or MS Excel. Tactical graphics have to be done by computerized programs compatible with MS Word and therefore adjusted and included into the written text.

A summary of a maximum of 15 lines has to be attached.

The head should be centered and contain the following lines:

- The title of the thesis in capitals and bold letters.
- The author's full name
- The federation and country

Order of the text:

Title, Summary, Keywords (5 as max.), Introduction, Methods, Development, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References.

References and quotations have to be done as follows:

Ref.: COX, R. H.: Sport Psychology (3rd ed.), Dubuque 1994

Quot.: "...." (COX, 1994, p. ..)

References and quotations taken from the internet have to follow international use.





Submission Guidelines for the Theses 2

The thesis might be done in your first language but a justified translation in English language has to be submitted to the EHF office in electronic form to the following address:

Submission deadline is Oct.12th (first submission), feedback will be sent by Oct.29th the latest. In case of any correction necessary the deadline for the second edition will be Nov. 16th. Along with the submission of the thesis a CV has to be sent to the said address.

Criteria of the evaluation of your submission will be formal on one hand rating and in terms of content, originality and stringent of the ideas and follow through on the other hand.
