- Resistant; able to work under pressure



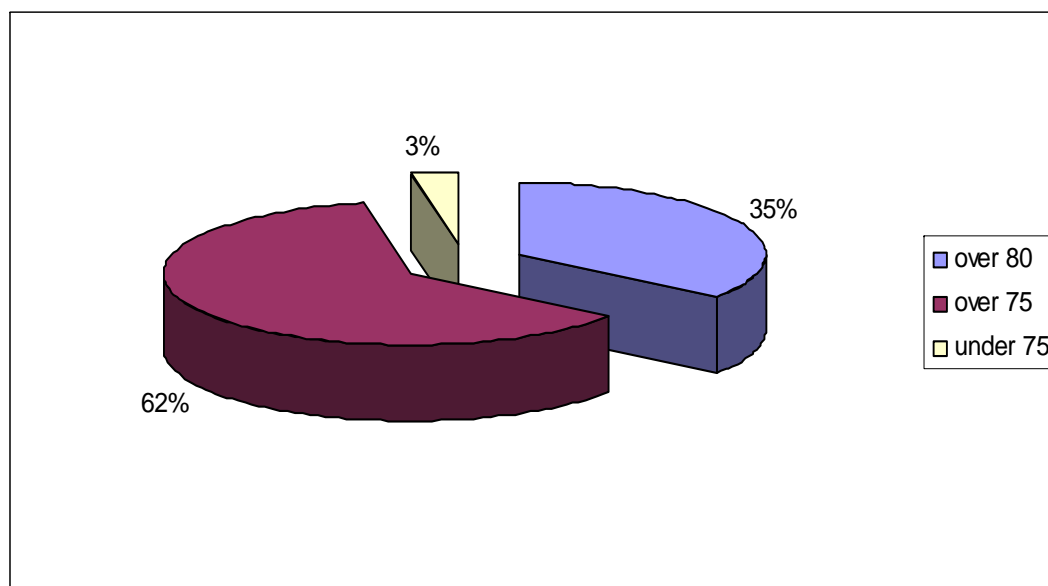
Performances Ref / Del 04/05
