


## How to settle our lines and keep them

## Rule 16 (16:1 – 16:5)

# Suspensions...

#### Can be given:

- i. Errors and similar infringements against the opponent
- ii. Infractions that we punish progressively
- iii. Unsportsmanlike conduct of a player/official





#### Must be given:

- i. For illegal substitution or when a player from the substitution area, interfere improperly in the game
- ii. For repeatedly infractions that we punish them progressively
- iii. For repeatedly unsportsmanlike conduct of a player (inside or outside the playing area)



# Direct red cards







Direct red cards (continue)

A direct red card must given to the following situations:

- √For infractions that endanger the physical integrity of the opponent
- ✓ For infractions of G/k, when coming out of the goal area and with the energy of endangering the physical integrity of the opponent
- √ For serious unsportsmanlike conduct of a player/official (inside or outside the court)
- √For assaults (player or official)
