EBT Tournaments....where are we?

An event for whom....?

After the first two EChs, in Italy and Spain, was becoming clear for EHF that was arrived the moment to provide the Euroepan Beach Handball Community of a tournament system that could give clear rules and a clear point system in order to achive the result of playing a final torunament on the standards of Beach Vollley Tour



Therefore in 2004 the EBT tournamnet competiotion system started, and the first organizer for the at the time so called EBT Masters was again Italy, as for the first Ech in Gaeta, and this time was the city of Salerno the spot where the top ten man teams and the top 5 women teams joined to play for the title

 The first EBT winner for men was LETO 2002 form Serbia, and for women was Policastelliri from Italy




- From that moment here are the cities that organized the EBT
 Masters, from 2010 renamed as EBT Finals to distinguish from
 the new born project of EHF Handbal Masters CHs:
- 2005 Suances (ESP), 2006 Katerini (GRE), 2007 Nagyatad (HUN), 2008 Valencia (ESP) the first with the standard 8+8 teams, 2009 Meliti-Issos (GRE), 2010 Espinho (POR), 2011
 Fuengirola (ESP), 2012 Lagoa (POR), 2013 Umag (CRO), 2014
 Thessaloniki (GRE) the first with the new standard of 10+10
 teams and finally 2015 Budgers (HUN).



 Slowly the growing quality of technical skills of the teams convinced the EHF BC to make use of this event to improove the education of the BH officials, from 2010 in Espinho in fact every two years the EHF course for delegates, referees and coaches is run parallel to the EBT Finals



But not only.....: in fact the problem always faced in the BH Echs was how to approach the matches from officials that are coming straight away from the indoor season, therefore came the decision to use the EBT finals in every odd year (the year of the Senior Echs) as a pre education tournament for all those officials nominated more or less two months later for the biggest event organized by EHF





 The beginning was quite tough as the expectatives of the teams coming to compete for a European title in EBT Finals is to have always the best referees for the best matches, and when we speak about referess coming to a course for getting the EHF badge cannot be like that.

 But the so different attitude of BH people from indoor very very fast accepted this improvement and the collaborative spirit from officials and players is the best testimonial of our education process for our EHF Officials THO EHF 2012 React Handhall Compliants



- It goes beyond saying that not everything was "roses and flowers" as always happen when new competitions and new events are trying to be standardized
- The beginning was clearly in a direction to leave the doors open for everybody accepitng even low standars consequently to the principle that the most important point was to spread "the word of Beach Handball" all over Europe



The tremendously fast increasing of number of teams and number of EBT Tournament organized, requested very soon to act immediatley with more strict regulation in respect of our discipline and of the teams who almost professionally are yearly involved in BH activity, even the increasing number of EHF officials that could be used of course influneced the decision to put in any tournament the obligatory EHF Delegate presence or minimum of a National Observer indicatec by the NF.



- This decision was taken in 2010 accordingly to the need to stengthen the necessity of control the points attribution in the various tournament making consequyently a division between organizers
- The number of tournaments, due to this restriction and the contemporary increasing of general standards for points atribution, made the number of EBT Torunaments dropping down from 45 in 2010 to 37 in 2012.



- We are now happy to say that the decision finally paid off: from
 2013 the number of Tournaments restared to grow reaching in
 2015 the number of 56 with a total of 152 team (maximum
 number since the establishing of EBT Torunaments) involved!
- The quality of organizers is always better: the effort to improve standards with scoreboards, EHF Officials involved, number of teams invited from all over Europe and so on gives now to our EBT Tournaments a real professional face



Next challenges.....

- Next step is of course directed to develop a new marketing strategy, that starting from top European competions may affect even the world of private Tournaments. In a peridod of economic crisis the need to economize resources and find new way to promote BH with possible sponsors must be developed.
 A lot of processes and programms for developing beach sports
 - connected to tourism and wellness are in the aim of European Community, we absolutely need to get inside them.
