Before the match.....

Everything starts when we pick up the match report in the CPO.

Our first task will be to check the playing court: it has to be free from any objects





Checking the secretary
table will be as well
important: reserve clock,
suspension cards, TTO cards
(to be delivered to team
officials).....





Delegates always have to support referees....



When everything will be in order and under control then it will be the time for some conversation with the team officials of both teams (spend almost same time with them) about “fair play” and for any clarification they need and might be useful for a fluent game.





During the match.....

- What are our competences?
- Visual contact with referees
- How to check the regular development of match report?
- Take notes about what is going on on the court





During the match.....

- Check regular time stopping and regular scoring by Timekeeper and Secretary
- Give same opportunity to both substitution areas , considering the distance of table





After the match.....

- Deliver and get back the “referee’s evaluation” paper to both teams
- Check the match report , sign it together with Timekeeper, Secretary, Referees
- Take it to the CPO tent





After the match.....

- Now is “referees time” : the most important moment for education and development of our referees
- Choose the right way to express your ideas, your feelings and vision about the match, the progressive line.





How to manage a protest:

Protests shall be announced to the EHF delegate orally after the end of the match

The reason of the protest shall be handed over in writing within 30 min after the end of the match. At the same time a protest fee of 400€ has to be paid. If the protest is accepted the deposit will be refunded.

The EHF Disciplinary Commission takes its decision by a simple majority 1h before the start of the next match of the team concerned

All decisions taken by the Disciplinary Commission (1stand 2ndinstance) are final decisions.
