- **2014 MECH in DEN**
- Just two foreign national coaches:
- AUT: Patrekur Johannesson- ISL
- POL: Michael Biegler

- **2016 MECH in POL**
- *The number of the foreign coaches incriedes on 7!*
- **16 teams,256 players: 143 playing abroad and113 at home!**
  
- POL: Michael Biegler- GER
- GER: Dagur Sigurdson-ISL
- SLO: Veszelin Vujovic- SRB
- DEN: Gudmundur Gudmundson- ISL
- HUN: Talant Dushebajev- ESP
- MKD: Ivica Obrovan-CRO
- MNE: Ljubomir Obradovic- SRB
- **2-2 ISL,SRB, 1-1 CRO,ESP, GER**

- *Comparing to MECH 2014/DEN to the MECH 2016/POL from 14 Nations 7 changed their national coaches:*
- **CRO,DEN,HUN,SRB,NOR,RUS,MNE**
- 2016:GER and SLO participate instead of AUT and CZE and they changed the coach too, so,from 16 teams play 9 with new coach.
- A lot of countries brought a new one because unsuccess from last years: HUN,CRO,SRB,RUS,MNE

- **2014 WECH HUN/CRO**

- 3 teams had played with foreign coaches:

- **3 DEN, 1-1 ISL,SWE, KOR**
- *From 6 coaches 5 are from Scandinavia and Island !*

*In the last years was usually, that almost just a domestic coach worked parallel as a club and as a national team coach at the same time in the same country:*

POL: B. Wenta

HUN: K. E. Böhn

HUN: L. Mocsai

*The preparation time became shorter and shorter for the national teams.*

**These clubs were almost identical with the national teams, so, the coaches could practice and form both teams during the season, it was an advantage for the national teams.**

- **Nowadays some coaches work also parallel with a club - and a national team, but in different countries!**
- T. Dushebaev: Kielce /POL/ and HUN national team
- M. Biegler: Hamburg /GER/ and POL
- M. Cadenas: Plock /POL/ and ESP
- K. Rasmussen: Bucharest /ROU/ and POL
- V. Vujovic: Zagreb /CRO/ and SLO
- I. Obrovan: Toluse /FRA/ and MKD
  
- **Just Cadenas /ESP/ works as national coach at home!**
- **The double load is a big pressure for the coaches.**
- **Above mentioned: 143 players earn their salary abroad.**



- **Hungary,2015/16, First Leagues**

- **Men's:**

- *14 teams,5 foreign coaches, 86 foreign players, cca. 6/team*
- *The coaches are from:2-2 ESP,SRB, 1 MNE*

- 1. place, Veszprém:13 foreign players, ESP coach
- 2. place, Szeged: 11, ESP
- 3.place, Tatabánya: 6, SRB

- 9. place,Komló: 9, SRB
- 10.place, Orosháza 8, SRB

- **The different of the foreign players quality and not the quantity determinate the ranking.**
- **The top teams in HUN /national team, Veszprém, Szeged/ has ESP coach.**

- **Women's:**

- 12 teams, 7 foreign coaches, 48 foreign players, 4/team
- The coaches are from: 2 SLO, 1-1 ESP, DEN, CRO, RUS CZE
- 1.place, 2 foreign players, HUN coach
- 2.place, Győr 8 , ESP
- 3.place, Siófok, 8, DEN

- **The best 26 HUN teams have 12 foreign coaches and 134 foreign players /cca. 5/teams/.**

- *Where are the HUN coaches and players? The fact is, that they are not abroad. It means, that the number of the top HUN players and coaches decreased.*

- **Advantage for the coach:**

- Finances: salary, premium, flat, car, free air ticket food, etc.
- Respect and confidence for players and leaders
- Motivation of the players
- Attention and protection from players and leaders
- Exhibition himself
- Believability and credibility
- Much toleration from the stakeholders

- **Disadvantage for the coach:**
- Domestic language, direct communication
- Using the translator
- Missing family, friends, mother tongue
- Spending leisure time
- Passive and active resistance of domestic coaches
- Lack of the domestic handball philosophy, national character, habit and behaviour
- Some time the expectation to big, no realistic.
