Hosting City - Thessaloniki, Greece

Thessaloniki is the second-largest city in Greece and the capital of the region of Macedonia, the largest and second most populous Greek region.

Thessaloniki's honorary title is "co-capital", and stands as a reference to its historical status as the "co-reigning" city of the Byzantine Empire, alongside Constantinople.

Thessaloniki

Thessaloniki lies on the northern fringe of the Thermaic Gulf on its eastern coast and is bound by Mount Hortiatis on its southeast. Its proximity to imposing mountain ranges, hills and fault lines, especially towards its southeast have historically made the city prone to geological changes. In 2011 reached a total of 1,006,730 inhabitants.

Thessaloniki is Greece's second major economic, industrial, commercial and political centre, and a major transportation hub for the rest of southeastern Europe; its commercial port is also of great importance for Greece and the southeastern European hinterland.

Avant Garde Sports Club (www.ebtfinals2016.gr)

Avant Garde Sports Club is located in Kardia about 20km southeast of Thessaloniki.

A private multiplex built on a hillside in an area of 80 acres, surrounded by 3,500 trees, overlooking Thessaloniki and the Thermaikos Gulf. The complex features sporting facilities, restaurants, congress/social events hall, children playground, leisure facilities and swimming pools, folk art museum, and a church.



EHF Beach Handball Commission

The EHF Beach Handball Commission regards itself as an initiator of projects in order to develop Beach Handball as an independent sport discipline within the European Handball family. One of the main targets of the BC is the education of facilitators. Combined educational courses of referees, delegates and coaches have been organised since 1999.




