Everyone who dreams of becoming great referee should know, how important is the game management. In this expression ruling on the playing court, judging players behaviour and deciding what type of foul is punished are hidden. And obviously many, many others.



Rules concern game management:

17:1 Two referees with equal authority shall be in charge of each game.

They are assisted by a timekeeper and a scorekeeper.

17:2 The referees monitor the conduct of the players from the moment they enter the premises until they leave.



17:3 The referees are responsible for inspecting the playing court, the goals and the balls before the game starts; (...) The referees also establish the presence of both teams in proper uniforms, check the score sheet and the equipment of them players, ensure that the number of players and officials in the substitution area is within the limits.



17:7 (...) It is their responsibility to ensure that the game is played in accordance with the rules, and they must penalize any infractions

17:13 Decisions made by the referees, including those based on delegates' recommendations, on the basis of their observations of facts or their judgments are final.

Many features of good referee can be highlighted. Attitude, approach, body language, plenty of tiny details together mean a lot.

If we gain respect from players, coaches and audience, we will feel more comfortable on the playing court, and our decisions will be though better received.

Leadership as BH referees

Mainly characteristic of good referees:

- Knowledge of the rules,
- Confidence and courage,
- Ability to make quick and correct decisions,
- Good approach and attitude,
- "Feeling the game" (advantage)
- Clear gesticulation and body language

Advantage

13:2 The referees should allow continuity in the game by refraining from interrupting the game prematurely with a free-throw decision.

Very important ability, which can be key in the game. Referees should really take care to do not interrupt the game if it is not necessary.



Great advantage – team need 1 point to win the match
