The following regulations are binding rules for events organised by the IHF and the continental confederations.

They are also to be used as recommendations for matches at all levels of competition.

Long-sleeved undershirt	allowed	same colour as main colour of the shirt, thin material
T-shirt for court player acting as goalkeeper	allowed	identical to goalkeeper shirt, holes for front and back number, covered with transparent material
Short undershorts	allowed	same colour as pants, thin material
Long undershorts	not allowed	
Long pants	not allowed	exception: goalkeeper
Socks		same colour and length
Clothing of officials		standardised, dressed in sportswear or civilian clothing; uniform colour, different from shirt colour of the court players of the opposing team

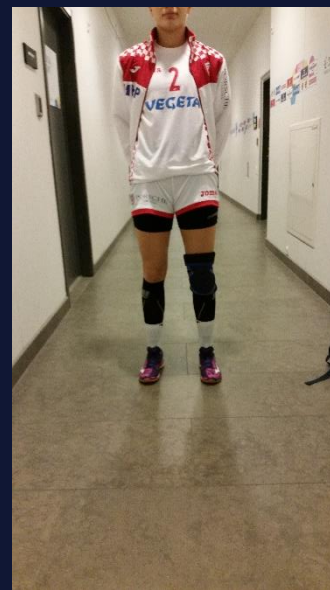

EHF Coaching Licensing (category 3) obligatory for all EHF Competitions as of 2014/15 (no more transition period – monitoring of young coaches in the educational process)

**EHF PRO Licence Renewal as of 2016 (transition 2017)
EHF/IHF clinics, National clinics with EHF/IHF lecturers
(minimum 16 hours) – FREE CHOICE OF DATE**

**EHF PRO Licence obligatory
for 2020 EHF EUROS and CL as of the 2020/21 season**

**Exemptions for current top National Team/Club coaches t.b.d.
(e.g.: 1 module out of 3, 2 summaries, 1 thesis)**

This letter is to certify that on September the 30th 2016, the Governing Council of the University of Las Palmas approved the postgraduate degree entitled **EHF Master Coach**, published in the Official Bulletin of the ULPGC (BOULPGC nº11, 7th October 2016) (https://www2.ulpgc.es/descargadirecta.php?codigo_archivo=7120919).

The EHF Master Coach is a postgraduate degree composed by 60 ECTS credits, under the academic direction of Dr Miguel Angel Betancor (Professor of the University of Las Palmas) and by supervision of Mr Helmut Hörtsch (European Handball Federation Education & Development - Senior Manager). This university degree will be developed in close collaboration between European Handball Federation and the University of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.

The degree includes more than 20 university professors and experts with international recognition, with a theoretical and practical training divided into 4 categories and levels of training. It is a novel and unique degree at the international level and represents a milestone in the cooperation between University and sport Organizations.

Cooperation EHF - University Las Palmas / ESP

2 possible Academic Certifications
according to the academic qualifications of candidates:

1) European Post Graduate Master Degree: for students with a University Degree

EU countries: notarized copies of University Degrees translated into English/Spanish have to be provided

Non-EU countries: copies of University Degrees translated into English/Spanish as well as a confirmation from the university about the “proper knowledge/ education” of the candidate have to be provided (recognized/compatible to Bologna system)

Fees: approx. EUR 200.- ECTS registration
approx. EUR 300.- Certificate Fee

2) Quality Certification Training Programme: for students who do not have a University Degree

Copies of high school diploma, a written confirmation (stamp and signature) of fulfilling the Federation or Institutional requirements for Categories II and III in terms of EHF RINCK Convention have to be provided!

For the correct recognition of the EHF RINCK Convention System an **academic committee** consisting of handball experts with academic background will be formed for analysing all applications!

System for the recognition of ECTS credits earned in each Category

Categories I + II - 18 ECTS

Category III - 20 ECTS

Category IV (Master Coach) includes 16 ECTS of theoretical / practical teaching plus Master Final Project with at least 6 ECTS. All together (18 + 20 + 16 + 6) will reach 60 ECTS as the level of Post Graduate Master

Concerning the Master Final Project (6 ECTS), formal requirements (structure, conditions) will be laid down by the University (Scientific research in cooperation with the EHF recognized handball coaching experts required)
