- RUS /1.place/, FRA /2/, NOR 6 /3/, NED /4/, ESP /6/, SWE /7/, ROU /9/, MNE /11/.
- SLO and CZE participate instead of SVK and UKR at the WECH in 2016.
- Correlate to WECH 2014 **from 14 teams 10** arrived with new coach!!
- MECH 2016: **9 coach from 16** teams are new since the last MECH /2014/

Players Are Playing Abroad

16 teams, 256 players: 149 play at home and 107 abroad

- Average: **7 players** from each team play not in their country!

Offence

Simply actions:

- -CB crosses LP
- -transition of the wing players without ball and with ball, cross for the opposite side
- -"YUG" cross
- -CB cross winger, BP cross opposite side for BP or for winger

• -

- Numerical inferiority: player substitut for goal keeper
- Just few goals in the empty goals
- -Sometimes, closed to the end of the game some teams try to play 7:6
- The meaning of the winger's performance is important
- Using the fast thow off: NED scored 12 goals
- -Numerical superiority: the teams used mostly short transition from LB, RB position
- „BL1, BL2”

Defence

- Generally the teams used 6:0 system, but they changed it for 5:1 and 5+1 particularly in numerical superiority
- MNE played 5:1
- SWE and DEN changed 6:0, 5:1, 3:2:1 system during the game, sometimes during one attack, if it was necessary
- The teams used „ball traps” in the defence
- The teams changed 1-2 players from offence to defence

Refereeing: the mostly discussed points:

- Punishment, double punishment
- Red cards
- Video referee
- Violations related the line players
- Entering in the goal area
- Passive play
