EHF Coaching Licensing as of 2016

EHF Coaching Licensing (category 3) obligatory for all EHF Competitions as of 2014/15 (no more transition period – monitoring of young coaches in the educational process)

EHF PRO Licence obligatory for 2020 EHF EUROs and CL as of the 2020/21 season



EHF PRO Licence Renewal as of 2016

- transition period 2017
- EHF/IHF clinics, National clinics with EHF/IHF lecturers/
 EHF Master Coaches
 - minimum 16 hours
 - FREE CHOICE OF RENEWAL DATE





National PRO Licence renewal courses were held in AUT, DEN, HUN, NOR and SLO.

There are currently appr. 300 coaches with the EHF PRO licence and appr. 450 coaches with the EHF Master Coach title.

Concerning the planned IHF Coaches' Licensing System, the European Coaches of EHF RINCK Conventions Signatories have to fulfil the <u>criteria of the EHF Coaching Licensing in EHF competitions</u>.





National Master Coach Courses

- Courses possible for EHF RINCK Convention Signatories on Level 3 only
- Written Confirmation by National Federation for Level 3 Applicants (all courses should be accessible for all participants with the respective licence, including foreigners with the respective language command).
- All modules of the course should be finished within one year (12 months).





National Master Coach Courses

- Minimum 160 hours (number of modules t.b.d.)
 carried out and administered by the organizing Federation
- The organizers should prove to the EHF that the programme of the course meets the criteria of the RINCK Convention.
- 1 International Coaching Lecturer approved by EHF (The local organizer should provide a translator for the EHF lecturers' presentations)



National Master Coach Courses

- The responsibility of examinations is with the local organisers, however a summary of all theses (in English language) has to be provided to the EHF and will be published on the EHF website.
- EHF Master Coach Certificates and PRO Licences issued by the EHF

Whom it may concern:

This letter is to certify that on September the 30th 2016, the Governing Council of the University of Las Palmas approved the postgraduate degree entitled *EHF Master Coach*, published in the Official Bulletin of the ULPGC (BOULPGC n°11, 7th October 2016)

The EHF Master Coach is a postgraduate degree composed by 60 ECTS credits, under the academic direction of Dr Miguel Angel Betancor (Professor of the University of Las Palmas) and by supervision of Mr Helmut Höritsch (European Handball Federation Education & Development - Senior Manager). This university degree will be developed in close collaboration between European Handball Federation and the University of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria

The degree includes more than 20 university professors and experts with international recognition, with a theoretical and practical training divided into 4 categories and levels of training. It is a novel and unique degree at the international level and represents a milestone in the cooperation between University and sport Organizations.

1) European Post Graduate Master Degree: for applicants with a University Degree

Requirements:

European Union (EU) countries: notarized copies of University Degrees (PhD, Master,

Bachelor) translated into English/Spanish have to be provided

Non-EU countries: copies of University Degrees translated into English/Spanish as well as

a confirmation from the university about the "proper knowledge/

education" of the applicant have to be provided (recognized/compatible to "EU Bologna system")

Fees: EUR 200.- ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)

registration/administration fee

EUR 300.- Post Graduate Master Certificate Fee

2) Quality Certification: for applicants who do not have a University Degree

= Academic certification by the EHF - University Las Palmas academic committee according to the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)

Requirements: A copy of a high school diploma (notarized translation into Spanish/ English)

A written EHF confirmation (stamp and signature) of fulfilling the federation or institutional requirements for Categories II and III of the

EHF RINCK Convention has to be provided (by EHF)

EUR 200.- ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) registration/administration fee

For the correct recognition and academic certification of the EHF RINCK Convention
System an academic committee of EHF handball lecturers with academic
background will be formed for analysing all applications together with the
University Las Palmas



EHF Master Coach Certification Cooperation EHF - University Las Palmas / ESP System for the recognition and academic certification of ECTS credits earned in each Category

Categories I + II - 18 ECTS

Category III - 20 ECTS

CategorIV (Master Coach) includes 16 ECTS of theoretical/practical teaching plus Master Final Project with at least 6 ECTS. In total (18 + 20 + 16 + 6) 60 ECTS will be reached as the level of Post Graduate Master (Academic EHF Master Coach)

Concerning the Master Final Project (6 ECTS), formal requirements (structure, conditions) will be laid down by the University Las Palmas in cooperation with the EHF recognized handball coaching experts/lecturers with academic background
















The goal


