as well as PRO Licence Renewal Courses
- ◆ EHF Coaching Licence (RC Category 3)
 - mandatory in all EHF Club and National
Team Competitions as of the 2014/15 season



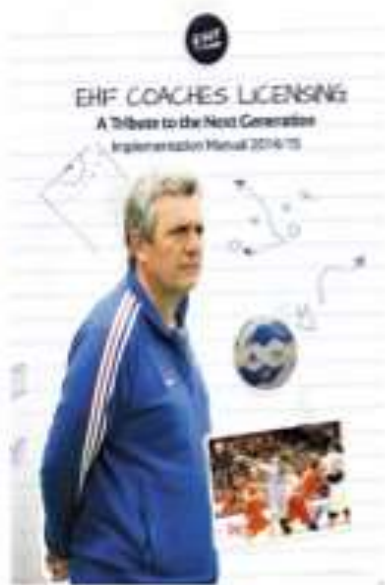
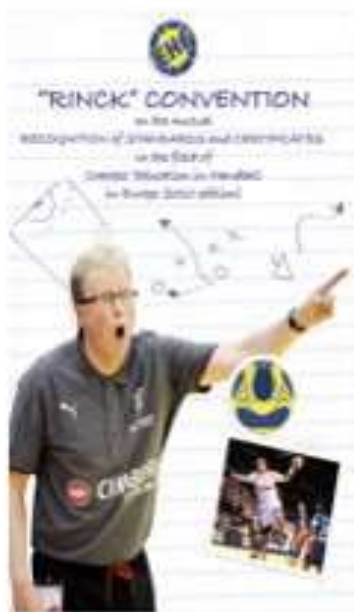

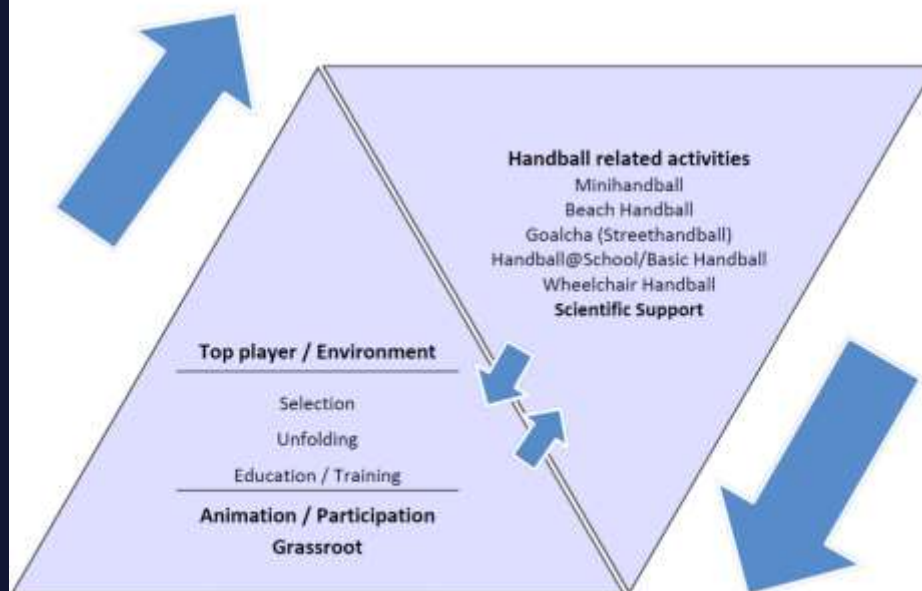

SOCIAL AESTHETICS

Social aesthetics is, ..., an aesthetic of the situation.
... Like every aesthetic order, social aesthetics is contextual. It is also highly perceptual, for intense perceptual awareness is the foundation of aesthetics. Furthermore factors similar to those in every aesthetic field are at work in social aesthetics, although their specific identity may be different ... creative processes are at work in its participants, who emphasize and shape the perceptual features.

TASKS OF SOCIAL AESTHETICS

- cultivation of human contacts and interactions
- introducing humanity in blank rituals and behaviors
- creation of atmospheres and offering hospitality
- deconstruction of barriers and push back boundaries
- enabling to establish *beautiful* situations/relations
- opening up new perspectives for human future, ...

COLUMNS OF SOCIAL AESTHETICS

- full acceptance of the others (esteem)
- heightened perception (p. of sensuous qualities)
- freshness and excitement of discovery (fascination)
- recognition of the uniqueness (individuum/situation)
- full personal involvement (engagement/opening)
- relinquishing of restrictions and exclusivity
- abandonment of separateness (places/atmospheres)
- mutual responsiveness („reciprocity“)

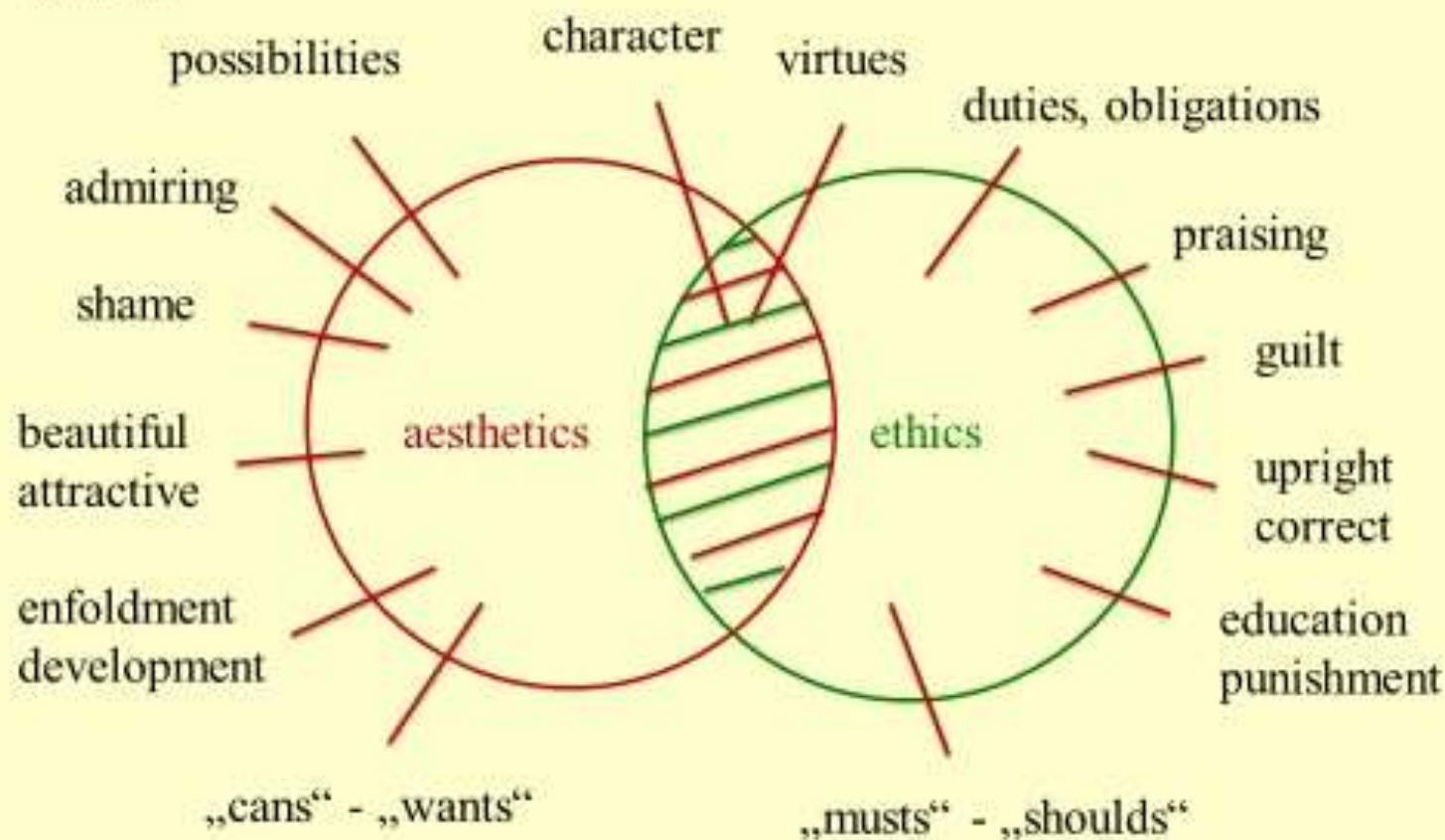
