Spin shot

Spin shot is a spectacular throw that brings 2 points and is performed in combination with a 360 degree jump.

A shot taken with full turn of body in the air.





WARNING!

During execution, referees need to pay attention to:



The position of the legs before performing shot;

correctly











Pay attention!

You should know!




99 % spin shots which execute with one leg – it's one point!







Full turn on 360 degrees or more;



During execution of a spin shot in the right or left corner, player should execute full a turn on 360 degrees or more (exactly corners often don't execute full turn).

There is no overstep on a 6 meter line (it's important not to bury feet in the sand)

Defence



During execution of the spectucular goals, players can do block, but only directly or back regarding to the position of the opponent's body

It should be noted that fighting and pushes to any parts of the body when performing a spin shot and in flight are punished with suspension or disqualification



The referees look at the correct execution of the spin shot and the ball hit;

If 1 or 2 points are credited when a goal is scored, then the court referee must indicate this by displaying 1 or 2 fingers.

When 2 points are awarded, the goal referee does a full vertical arm swing additionally



In flight

This is a spectacular throw that brings 2 points. A cathing and throw are performed during the jump



Two points are awarded only if the player who is in flight controls the ball and shots on goal while in the air ("slap" the ball or just "push" the ball into the goal is worth of a one-point goal)



In order to get 2 points the player must:

Jump out of the playing area without stepping into the goal area;

When catching a ball in a jump, the ball must be fixed. One point is awarded for a non-fixed ball.

The referees monitor the overstep in the goal area and the correct execution in flight.







During "shoot-out" players can execute spin shot or in flight, court referee should monitor correctly execute. Goal-line referee monitor scores a goal
