## Duties of a Delegate

- Need to be able to communicate with all parties involved in the official language
- Efficiency profesional knowhow of Beach Handball: the tactic and technique of the sport must be undertsand
- Being able to know and use the Rules of the Game
- Taking responsability of unpopular decisions
- Delegates must work with referees as a mentor
- Must coordiunate the issues and situations before, during and after the game



## **Duties of a Delegate**

- Correct sportsmanlike behavior
- Being there at least 30' prior to the game
- Area of Media, and eventual cameras postioning
- Team's clothing (special BH rules application)
- Must coordiunate the issues and situations before, during and after the game
- First to show the face at the end of the match
- Last to leave the court
- Closure of MR and Referees evaluation



#### 1. Fair play / Neutrality

Treating all players and officials of both teams absolutely neutral is important

#### 2. Steps

Correction of all kinds of moving

#### 3. Offensive faults

Rule infringements of the offensive player with and without ball possession

#### 4. Goal area / Defense

Distinction between violations committed deliberately and / or systematically and such not on purpose during 1 on 1 situations

#### 4bis. Goal area / Offence

Violation when aiming at the ball, entering during 1 on 1 situations, landed shots, stepping / falling inside before releasing the ball.

#### 5. 6m decisions

Correct restitution of a clear chance of scoring



#### 6.Passive play

Correct application of signals and calls in term of rules and idea of the game and the situation

#### 7. Refs positioning

Good team work with corrections according to different on court situations

#### 8. Reading the Game, Hollywood act

Good idea of the game and interpretation of rules leading to a game flow or break the rhythm of the game by interferences (unnecessary calls). Recognizing the Hollywood actions.

#### 9. Advantage

Correct application of the rules and same balance on either side

#### 10. Body Language/ Signals

Use of body language to set the line and use of internal signals and clear signaling to the players



#### 11. Straight line

Clear and strict calls supporting the players to identify the clear line of decisions taken.

#### 12. Atmosphere

Ability of entering in BH atmosphere facilitating the interpretation of fair play rule in the game

#### 13. Progressive punishment

Clear and strict line in accordance to the rules

#### 14. Cooperation with the table

Signals and mutual assistance. Clear calls on punishments. Continuous contact

#### 15. In flights

Correctness of basic issues in evaluation of spin-shots in particular for timing imgrabbing the ball and landing after shooting

#### 16. Spin-shots

Correct and straight line of evaluation during the game of jumping position of feet and shooting before landing



#### **RATING:**

- (--) not satisfactory: many mistakes, influencing the game, loss of contyrol
- (-) poor: many mistakes, no influence but little control
- (0) average: several mistakes, regular control
- (+) good: few mistakes and good control
- (++) very good, almost no mistake very good control
- (+++) excellent: (even related to the difficulty of the match) practically perfect

PERFORMANCE SUMMARY: flow of referee performance during the game

MATCHTYPE: evaluation based on behavior of teams, quality of the game and importance for the ranking

**INFLUENCE:** how the referee performance influenced the match.
