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1. After a coin toss team A wins and chooses the end. Team B

2. At the end of the first half the score is 10-10
 - a) Take a break and award one match point to each of the teams
 - b) The "Golden Goal" method will be used
 - c) 5 minutes extra time
 - d) Sudden death, after referee throw

3. The score of the first half is 12-12
The "Golden Goal" method is used. The game will start with
 - a) Team A
 - b) Referee throw

4. What is the minimum number of players who must be present on the court at the beginning of the game?

5. Two players of each team like to wear sport shoes. The two coaches come to an agreement.

15. Goalkeeper B16 leaves the court over the sideline of his own teams' goal area and Goalkeeper B1 enters the court over the sideline in the substitution area.
- Play continues
 - Suspension of B16
 - Suspension of B1
 - Free throw to team A, from where B1 entered the playing court.
16. The score of the first half is (Team A) 10- (Team B) 11, and the score of the second half is (Team A) 12 - (Team B) 11
- Team A is the winner
 - Team B is the winner
 - Golden goal, because of the result 22 – 22.
 - The “Shoot Out” method will be used.
17. The ball is on the ground and player A2 is standing near. B3 is diving for the ball from a distance of 2-3 meters away; he plays the ball without any infraction and scores a goal.
- Goal. 1 point is awarded.
 - Goal. 2 points are awarded, because of the players “In flight” action
 - Suspension to B3 and free throw for team A
 - Free throw for team A

19. Player A2 scores a goal against team B. The game restarts with

20. In a “Shoot Out” situation team A has only four players eligible to play.
- Only 4 throwing opportunities for team A
 - The captain of the team can take two throws
 - Any player can take two throws
 - One of the punished players can take the last throw
21. When the team B has the ball in attack, their official behaves in a seriously unsportsmanlike manner against the referees. He tells the referees that they are stupid and kicks into the sand. The reaction from the referees shall be
- After time-out the referees give the official a disqualification.
 - The red card shall clearly be showed to the official of team B, the delegate, and the spectators.
 - Restart the game with a free throw for team A and reduce team B with one player on the court until the next change of possession of the ball.
 - After the game make a written report to the right authorities.
22. Team A's goalkeeper saves an “in flight” shot from B9. He throws the ball directly to A6 that has a clear chance to score a goal, when the timekeeper whistles on direct order from the delegate. Delegate explains that B3 entered the court before B9 has left it.
- Free throw for team A from the substitution area of team B. Suspension for B3.
 - Team B awarded a goalkeeper throw after suspension of B9.
 - Suspension of B3. Six meter throw for team A.
 - Team A awarded a 6-meter throw after the suspension of B9.



23. The table of the time- and scorekeeper shall have room for 3 to 4 persons. It shall be placed in the middle of sideline. How many meters from the sideline shall this table be placed?
