Topic 2 Group A

- All the countries in the Group have some kind of system within the YRP men and women couples, working or regionally in the country or with the regional Federation support
- For the evaluation is used system of mentoring support (former referees or delegates for home competitions) and different kind of tournaments and friendly international matches (young categories) in the coutry, where YR are officiating
- Delegates system very similar in each country, using delegates for the top competitions in each match (except NOR and ISL all tv games and 60% of other compettions top level)
- Observation is fixed for even YPR or other referees through the observes (in some coutries – MKD, RUS in all categorie competitions in each game) in some coutries just in the top competition and lower level competitions according the needs or for the observation of YR couple
- Delegates in each country are/or must be the former top referee or former top player and some coutries (for example ISL use the former top coaches as well)

Topic 2 Group A

- EHF support (needs and expectations):
- Some more possibility for interactive communication (through the EHF web side system) except of using the web portal
- Discuss about the limit of 50 years for end of the referee carrier (some countries have no age limit some of them different from official one which is 50
- Spread more the age limit for the YR categories

Topic Young Referee Project Group B

Improvements:

- GER: better communication in timing of EHF ref nominations; contact Del – Ref; EHF shall provide courses for Refs; problems in timing. Analysis of ref performance in EHF top level tournaments should be provided earlier

- SUI: clear line of standards for YR; no available places in the YR project; special education needs finances - € 5.000 per year
- AUT: EHF financial support for education exchange to other countries (education courses + tournaments)
