

When defending a player without the ball the defensive player must control with his/her vision the offensive player and the ball.
The use of peripheral vision is very important because he can control the movement of the ball and the player at the same time. This is one of the most complicated defensive fundamental.
As you can see in the diagram 2 red must be situated on the court in a position from which he can see his player (2) and the ball (1)

Presentation

Mental functioning is a key factor for sport high performance. Top performers in any sport, besides their athletic skills, show high levels of mental functioning most of the time, and in fact, very often, mental functioning is the difference between good performance and outstanding performance, between not achieving or achieving the athletic goals. Referees are also athletes, and therefore, their performance is also related to mental functioning.

As any other top athlete, international basketball referees, as well as having good officiating technique, good physical condition and enough experience, have developed, throughout their career, good psychological skills, and so, their mental functioning is probably very good most of the time. If you think in your own, you will probably find good psychological functioning, most of the time, both in training and games.

However, this is an area in which you can still improve, as it happens in the technical and the physical areas. Improving your psychological skills will help you to enhance your officiating performance, especially in critical situations.

During the clinics held in Munich and Las Palmas in the summer of 2008, a lecture on Psychology of Officiating was included within the programme. There, we discussed relevant psychological issues related to officiating performance. Here, through this web, we will remember and extend these topics, and further, we will be open to share any information about your own psychological experience, as well as to answer any doubt that you might have. The aim is to help your officiating performance by helping you to improve your psychological functioning.



 - Recovery

We will try to find a way to be ready for the referees when they need medical information or assistance from us.

- To prevent is better than to cure.
- For high performance it is necessary to have optimal weight and body fat %.





When tossing the ball for the jump ball at the start of the game, make sure that you throw it to the correct height. Not below, or above, just at the height that you need.

If you are an Umpire in 3PO, look for and key on to the ball to see that reaches the maximum height and at that point the players are touching it. Do not allow the ball to be stolen illegally. This is the first mistake that we officials allow or permit.

Remember that in the mechanics of 3PO, the second official is responsible to check the flight of the ball, the possible foul of the jumpers and is responsible to start the clock by signal when the ball is touched by one of the jumpers. The other official is responsible for the other eight players and any possible fouls they can make during this part of the game.

When there is defense with pressure or pressure in the zone, all of the officials should maintain the triangulation of your normal movement, but the same triangle will be larger or smaller depending on the effect of the press. Only look at the ball if it is inside the area that forms part of your primary coverage.

During the throw-in make the 5 second count visible, but do not utilize your fingers to do this.

In the same way, when acting as the Trail, make a visible count of eight seconds. Check with your peripheral vision the 24 seconds clock in order to make your count if it is necessary and if it you have to blow the whistle when it is the right time, not too soon or too late, but on
