SPIN SHOT

Differences between:

One point or

Two points Goals

HOW TO IDENTIFY A RIGHT SPIN **SHOT:**

GENERAL RULES:

FEET MUST BE FULLY FACING OPPONENT GOAL

**SO, BODY AND HIPS MUST BE FULLY FACING THE
OPPONENT GOAL BEFORE JUMPING**

P.S.: The rules don't distinguish if the spin is made jumping
with one or two feet.



ONE POINT GOAL



- .- THE PLAYER'S FEET AND HIPS ARE NOT FULLY FACING OPPONENT GOAL WHEN HE/SHE STARTS THE SPIN
- .- THE SHOT IS BEFORE THE FULL SPIN (full spin = 360°)
- .- THE PLAYER STARTS THE SPIN ON THE SAND
- .- THE PLAYER FALLS DOWN BEFORE THE SHOT (obviously, if he/she is not within goal area and not travelling)





ONE POINT EXAMPLE





TWO POINTS GOAL REQUIREMENTS

- FEET MUST BE ON THE SAND BEFORE THE SPIN STARTS
- BODY AND HIPS MUST BE FULLY FACING OPPONENT GOAL
- 360 DEGREES SPIN IN THE AIR
- SHOT AT GOAL BEFORE FALLING DOWN
