- Regional and national further education courses
- Young referee courses with accompanying tournament
- Continental seminars with examination
- EChs for different age categories: minicourse and daily meetings



Basics:

Limited nr. of participants – max 35 persons



- No big "speech" (frontal education) but interactive work system
- Time- and theme variations (to avoid monotony!)
- Check of language and theoretical skills in the meetings



- Technical facilities/ECh/Exam courses

Concentration on current trends in rules interpretation

Practical demonstration with active participating

MC representative







- Consultation with national chief of referees, accepting the wish of the host
- Experiences of the last Continental- and World Championships refereeing trends
- Check of physical condition, advices for physical preparation, nutrition program



- Regional- and national courses:
 - Referee running paths and positioning training
 - DVD test couple by couple
 - Crisis management in refereeing
 - Individual rules test





- Young referees competitions combined with courses:
 - Priority: more practical like theoretical work



- Opening meeting:
 - Short info regarding the tournament and special rules
 - Actual information on the "Young Referee Program"-criterias for awarding with badge
 - Focusing on the last experiences -rules interpretation highlights
- Daily meetings. Interactive, interesting situations during the day – find a common line
- Info to the national federations



- Continental courses with examination
 - Participants from two different directions
 - Age limit!
 - Women's project
 - MC representative (lecture)
 - Theoretical and practical tests





- Continental courses with examination
 - Language knowledge
 - Tasks for the "reserve referees"
 - Evaluation talk with the referees
 - In plenum
 - individually





Continental championships:



- External and internal lecturers
- Basic info regarding the competitions
- Different kind of tests (with DVDs)
- Teambuilding regular physical activity
- Highlights in rules interpretation



Continental championships:



- Evaluation of "homework" involving the consultants
- Daily meetings (short, concentrated on main experiences from day before)
- Usage of modern training facilities (e.g. DVD)
- Clear advices and good cooperation of all participants
