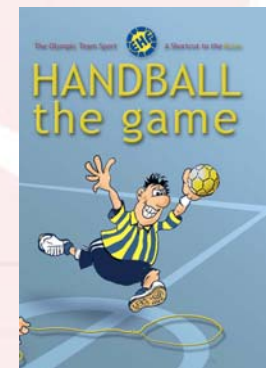

EHF CAN Philosophy/Preamble
